We are happy to offer a job opportunity as a Senior Building Inspector with DuPage County Building and Zoning Division of the Public Works Department. This position is primarily responsible for obtaining, where possible, voluntary compliance with code requirements and standards for construction in DuPage County.

- Inspects structures during all stages of construction for conformance with County ordinances and building and zoning codes
- Provides assistance to property owners for correcting building deficiencies in conformance with the intent set forth in these codes
- Inspects damaged structures
- Prepares inspection documentation, including photographs required to support findings
- Represents the County in court regarding violation cases submitted for prosecution
- Maintains on-going surveillance of assigned area for building/ordinance compliance
- Keeps abreast of current methods and techniques
- Develops departmental cross training regarding zoning/drainage/building codes
- Performs drainage, zoning and fill inspections
- Schedules inspections
- Operates county vehicles
- Prepares daily reports
