## **Summer Employment – Field Assistants**

**May – August 2018**

**2 Positions Available\***

The Belleisle Watershed Coalition is looking for motivated, detail-oriented students to assist our Project Leader this summer collecting water samples and water quality monitoring; conducting stream assessments including determining state of erosion and noting aquatic and wildlife habitat; and assisting with our tree planting initiatives. The BWC has a field office in the Springfield/Hatfield Point area; however, the majority of this work will be done in field. As such, applicants should be comfortable working outside in all weather conditions with minimal supervision. Some of this work will be conducted by boat on the Belleisle Bay and a Pleasure Craft Operator's Licence would be an asset.

Candidates already involved in university/college studies in forestry, biology, or environmental science would find this experience a useful addition to their career development. Candidates should meet the following characteristics:

- Pursuit of college/university degree in related field
- Strong report writing skills
- Excellent organizational skills
- Ability to work safely in remote areas with minimal supervision
- Good communication skills for outreach events
- Own transportation to Springfield

Compensation: 35 Hours per week for a minimum of 8 weeks between late May and August 2018. Generally Monday to Friday but may be asked to help with outreach events on selected weekends. Salary will depend on qualifications but will be \$12 - \$13/hour range.
