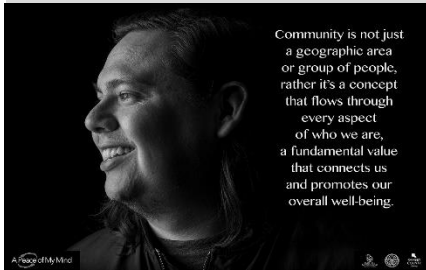

# 2022 GRANTS AWARDED



## Oak Hill Montessori/Shoreview Human Rights Commission/Ramsey County Library-Shoreview

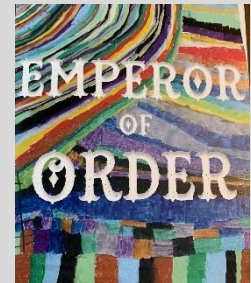
These entities used their grant to work together and bring the award-winning public art project, A Peace of My Mind, to the Shoreview Community. The project encompassed three outstanding elements including an on-site studio where portraits were taken and community members' responses to the question "What does community mean to you?" were recorded. Also, a 54-banner exhibit featuring compelling portraits and stories was displayed answering the question "What does peace mean to you?" Lastly, Award-winning photographer John Noltner presented universal lessons on hope, compassion, and building common goods based on his cross-country travels and interviews.

## Gallery 96 Art Center

Funds provided by the Shoreview Community Foundation assisted Gallery 96 in providing a Plein Air Painting in the Parks Series, allowing local artists of all levels and abilities to come together and appreciate the beauty of Shoreview's parks and truly see and capture the natural setting in front of the artist.

## Sacred Grounds Coffee House

Grant funds were used for Cow Tipping Press creative writing workshops. Cow Tipping is a unique program where creative writing classes are taught for and by individuals with developmental disabilities. The end result was a booklet created by the students with stories and poems in their own words. This picture is the cover of the booklet that was produced.



## Midwest Special Services

MSS used their grant to work with COMPAS to offer a series of eight classes with Terrell X., a popular musician MSS has worked with in the past. His engaging musical style encourages participation and movement for people with disabilities



## Arden Hills/Shoreview Rotary Club

A wonderful pollinator garden was installed at McCullough Park using grant funds. Seventy-five percent of the world's plant species are dependent on pollinators to survive. This pollinator garden will educate Shoreview residents the importance of pollinator gardens and how they can start one in their own yards. Twenty-seven volunteers planted 40 plant varieties.

Grants were also provided to North Suburban Chorus to offer concerts at several area senior living facilities, the Northern Lights Variety Band for instrument storage and securing features in their trailer, Shoreview Parks and Rec to provide youth programming at the farmers market, and Tubman to offer legal aid to those in the area who can't afford it.
