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Activate if trauma patient meets any of the following criteria:

Adult : Confirmed SBP<90 mmHG at any time (established by a second measurement in rapid succession)

Child (<10 years): SBP < 70 + (age x 2)

Compromised airway or ventilation requiring assistance (intubated, BVM)

Glasgow Coma Scale (GCS) less than 9, (or AVPU = responsive to pain or unresponsive), with torso and/or extremity trauma.

Obvious evisceration or major vascular injury with active hemorrhage

Penetrating injury to Head, Neck, Chest, Abdomen, Back or Groin

Patient transfer from other hospital receiving blood to maintain VS

Consider FTTA for anticipated arrival of >3 seriously injured patients

MODIFIED TRAUMA TEAM ACTIVATION CRITERIA

Activate if trauma patient meets any of the following criteria:

ANATOMY OF INJURY

MECHANISM OF INJURY (use clinical judgement)

<input type="checkbox"/> ROLLOVER of motor vehicle	<input type="checkbox"/> DEATH of same car occupant
<input type="checkbox"/> EJECTION (partial or complete) of patient from enclosed vehicle	<input type="checkbox"/> VEHICLE COMPARTMENT INTRUSION: > 12 inches occupant site > 18 inches any site
<input type="checkbox"/> EXTRICATION TIME > 20 min.	<input type="checkbox"/> Pedestrian/Bicyclist vs. moving vehicle
<input type="checkbox"/> COLLISION (i.e Motorcycle / ATV / Watercraft/ Snowmobile/ Bicycle)	<input type="checkbox"/> SEPARATION of rider from moving object (i.e. Animal / Motorcycle / ATV / Watercraft/ Snowmobile/ Bicycle)

BURN INJURY

For STRANGULATION OR NEAR DROWNING:

Use activation criteria above to determine trauma response level. Check with ED physician prior to paging Trauma Surgeon.

CO-MORBID FACTORS/TRIGGERS TO CALL ACTIVATION OR ↑ LEVEL

<input type="checkbox"/> ENVIRONMENT: extreme heat/cold	<input type="checkbox"/> Trauma with significant medical comorbidities.

FULL TRAUMA TEAM ACTIVATION CRITERIA
