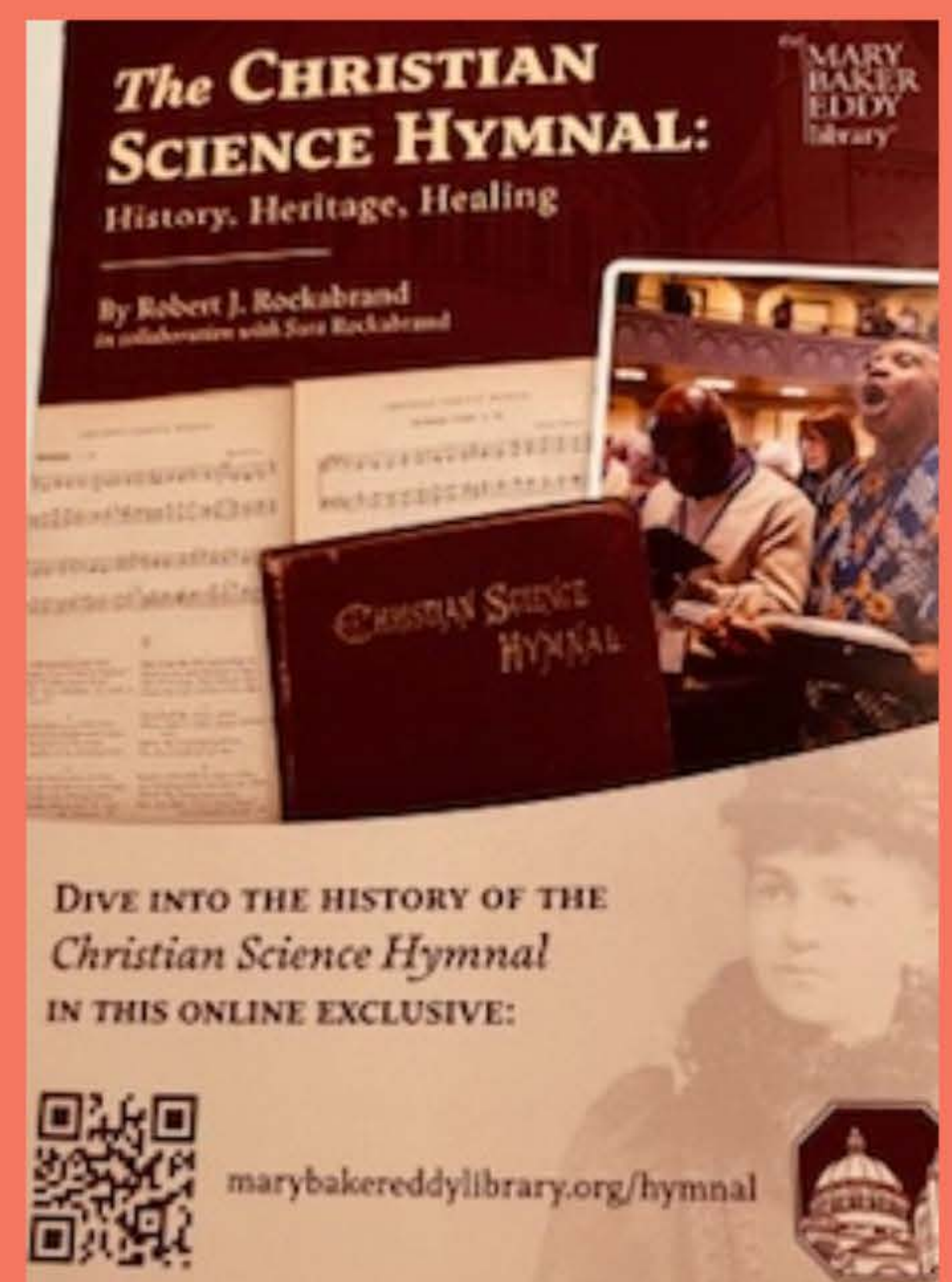
HYMNAL PROJECT
