On February 20, 2016 over 200 Tiger Inn alumni, partners, and spouses came to celebrate TI's 125th anniversary at the Westin in Princeton. Members arrived from up and down the eastern seaboard and represented sections from 1949 through 2015. John Bernard '49 was the oldest alumnus and outgoing President Grace Larson '16 and Vice President Cole Lampman '16 were the youngest in attendance.

During Hap Copper's '83 welcome remarks, a spontaneous contest of TI chants broke out among the younger and older alumni. The energy in the room became palpable as a chant came from one side of the room and then the other, both different but the same in the strong feelings for Tiger Inn.
