### **Greetings Parishioners**,

This morning I received news that Ohioans aged 40+ will be eligible for the CoVid19 vaccine this Friday March 19th. So by the time you are reading this article ...people in this young population will have had the opportunity to receive their first vaccination. With the news of the vaccine being available very soon to such a young population I intend for us to be out of the Convocation Center for 10:30am Mass beginning Easter.

Some may wonder ...what about those people under the age of 40 who will not be able to be fully vaccinated by April?

Or

What if I have been vaccinated but I am not yet ready to return to a smaller worship place like the Church by April?

Please don't fret if these questions come to mind, because we will still be offering a weekly safe Mass. On Easter Sunday we will offer a Mass with extra precautions at 1pm in St. Joseph Church. Also, beginning the following Saturday on April 10th we will be offering an extra Mass at 6:30pm each week at St. Joseph Church! Yes, for anyone from either parish who is still extremely worried about social distancing beginning Saturday April 10th we will be offering a new Saturday 6:30pm Mass at St. Joe's Church! This Mass is set aside for anyone who wishes to still social distance BEYOND the 6 foot recommendation. Also at this 6:30 Saturday Mass there will be "no music" for anyone worried about increased spread via singing.

Once again:

- A) Beginning Easter there will be no more 10:30am Masses in the Convocation Center and 10:30am Mass will return to the Church.
- B) Also there will be an extra weekend Mass available at St. Joe's Church on Saturdays at 6:30pm and this Mass will be for those who still wish to take increased extra precautions including:
- 1. Social Distancing beyond 6 feet.
- 2. Masks required ... including Fr. Jeff wearing a mask throughout the en tire Mass.
- 3. No singing at this Mass.

I'm glad that we are able to once again celebrate 10:30am Mass in the Church! I'm also glad to offer an extra Saturday 6:30pm Mass for any Sacred Heart or St. Joe's parishioners who still wish to celebrate Mass with a great abundance of extra precautions at 6:30pm Saturday evening at St. Joseph in Crestline.



## Safety for All

**Every child deserves a** safe environment. Ministry to children and young people is a privilege, not a right. The sexual abuse of minors is a crime and a grave sin. In accordance with diocesan policy, when a single act of sexual abuse is admitted or established, the offender is to be removed permanently from ministry. To help hold offenders accountable, report all abuse to local police authorities. You can also contact the diocesan victim assistance coordinator to make a report and seek outreach for the abused. These individuals are available to assist you in making a formal complaint of abuse to the diocese/eparchy, in arranging a personal meeting with the bishop or his representative, and for obtaining support for your specific needs. #### Fr. Jeff's Report:

Fr. Jeff met with the Cemetery Committee and discussed the mowing of the Cemetery grass during the summer months. Parish Advisory had heard complaints about it from several parishioners. Gary Biglin said he would talk to the mowing contractor before mowing season begins to make sure that he is aware of our parish's expectations (e.g. being mowed before Memorial Day weekend; being mowed for Festival weekend; and being mowed in a more timely manner so it doesn't get so high)

Easter Sunday Masses: Fr. Jeff will have the Easter Vigil and an 8:30 a.m. Mass @ Sacred Heart. He will have (3) Easter Sunday Masses at St. Joe's (7 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 1 p.m.)

Fr. Jeff will "open up" the four back pews on the Sacred Heart side where social distancing will not be necessary. His plan is to start out small, and then increase it as the Diocese permits.

Luminous Ministries: The tentative date is set for April 27, 2021, @ 7:15 p.m. (after the 6:30 p.m. Mass). This is a Mother/Daughter team, and they come highly recommended by the Diocese. They will also be presenting to the school children on April 28, 2021.

Fr. Jeff is considering an Open Gym for Basketball players who are 30 years old and older. He will possibly start this sometime in April. Watch the bulletin for updates.

Nick Vogt made a motion to install a handrail, Doug Lucius seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

### Attention 8th Grade Families !

Ohio EdChoice \$6,000. Scholarships are now available for Sacred Heart, St. Joseph and Crestline High School students to attend St. Peter's High School in Mansfield.

Students who live in Shelby school district can apply for an income based EdChoice Scholarship. The total gross income must be at or below 250% of the federal poverty guidelines. (\$66,250. for a family of four.)

Families who are active in parish life may also qualify for an additional \$2,000. Catholic Parishioner Scholarship, making the out-of-pocket costs for families very minimal. Transportation is also available.
