President's Message

I've had some requests to get back to answering frequently asked questions, so guess it's time to expand the FAQ list by talking about handicap adjustments and penalties.

The first thing to know is that every club authorized to maintain USGA handicaps must have a certified handicap person and a handicap committee. We have three people who have completed handicap training and passed the test, and in our case the board of directors serves as the handicap committee.

I hear a lot of talk about players being "penned" or **penalized** by the club.

The only penalties we issue are for failure to post a score or incorrect posting of a score. Since we switched to Golf Genius and hole by hole scoring for skins games and tournaments, we rarely deal with this for our events. Our main concern is that members post every eligible away round. Since we can't monitor all 300 members, we rely heavily on the honor system and peer review. If you hear about somebody shooting a low score somewhere, feel free to mention it to a board member, and we will verify that it was posted. If not, the member will be warned or penalized, depending on the situation. The standard penalty is a "penalty round", which means your lowest of your last 20 differentials is posted again, in addition to round you didn't post.

A more common occurrence is for indexes or handicaps to be **adjusted** based on "demonstrated performance". The GHIN system has built in automatic adjustments for individual exceptional rounds, which you will see if you shoot 7 shots better than you should on a given day. In your score list, you see an "E" added to the score type, and the previous 20 rounds are all lowered 1 or 2 strokes.

At the club level, the committee has a duty to adjust handicaps to assure fair competition, so we review cases monthly. The most common cases are members who score much lower in home vs. away rounds, or who score much lower in tournaments. When a member draws our attention, we analyze their scoring pattern to see if an adjustment is warranted. For example, we had a member who over 6 months had average differentials of 12 in away rounds, 9 in home rounds, and 6 in tournament rounds. Obviously, his index did not match his demonstrated ability in home and tournament rounds, which required us to adjust his handicap when playing in club events at El Prado. In another case, we had two members who always seem to do well in partner tournaments, but upon analyzing their score history, we found nothing unusual, so we didn't make any adjustments. Members can complain, and as much as we may want to adjust somebody because they win a lot of money, we only do it when we have real data to back up adjustments.

Tournament News

The June 2023 2 Man Scramble tournament showed some incredible scores with in the money finishing teams all in 9 under par range or better. Thanks to those who played, and thanks again to club member Lance Ford who assisted at the check-in table. We had 116 golfers/58 teams and paid out \$4,828. Our 50/50 drawing winners were: Joe Dyer, Kavi Singh, and Brian Robertson - each receiving \$80 in pot money. Congratulations to all the winners!

Friendly reminder: Please remember to **check your scorecards before signing and submitting** after your rounds. We've had several avoidable scoring incidents at our last two





tournaments where members trust that the scores have been recorded correctly. We all love our playing partner(s) and scoring competitor(s), but please double check scores before signing and submitting scorecards. And please read or ensure at least one member of the foursome **takes a rules sheet** from the check-in table. Taking these simple steps will eliminate the potential unpleasant conversation.

In Golf Genius news – Online signups for the 2 Man Scramble had no issues to report, and there were 39 messages from members to the event manager received through Golf Genius' email. The latter shows an increase of 10 messages from last month's event. Online signups for our Tuesday Skins game are consistently averaging 25 to 30 members.

Transitioning to online signups for Saturday Skins is still a topic of discussion at our board meetings. If you have any feedback or would like to add your thoughts on the topic, please share with any board member. Several challenges remain in our reluctance to shift the way we currently do Saturday skins signups. As you can imagine, Saturday's involve coordinating pairings and tee times for over 100 players each week, so we need to be careful in taking the next step.

The President's Cup match play event has finally concluded, and the payouts should be credited to your El Prado scrip within a week. The final match unfortunately ending in a concession with A-flight bracket winner Mike Anthony being crowned this season's President Cup champion. Congratulations Mike! If you have any questions about this year's President's Cup, please contact Doug.

9 months into our tournament year, we have a lot of happy golfers on the top 25 list. James Fanning is leading the pack, but several players jumped up the leaderboard in the last tournament. It should be an exciting finish to see who comes out on top at the end of the year!

Our next tournament is the July 15 Invitational, a 2 Man team event. This event typically fills up so register early! You can play this event as a member/member or member/guest team. If you've got a friend with a GHIN index, this is the month to invite them out. With 9 holes of scramble and 9 holes of better ball, it's geared towards fun, so your guest shouldn't worry about the pressure. Guests play to Low Index and need to have recent verifiable rounds posted. Tournament signups will close Tuesday July 11th. Sign your team up early to guarantee a spot. Don't forget online signups will close earlier if the player limit is reached before July 11th. We will confirm the roster of players in email on Wednesday July 12th before the tournament, and release tee times and pairings Friday July 14th.

It's a TEAM event and only one member needs to signup/register your team in GG. When Signups open, please follow these steps to register:

Step 1. <u>You or your Playing Partner</u> will need to navigate through the signup confirmation buttons by checking <u>playing</u>.

Step 2. Click on the <u>signup other members</u> link scroll and add your playing partner's name.

**SPECIAL NOTE: If you are inviting an outside guest, you must send a message to the event manager to include your guest partner's name and GHIN.

Step 3. If you choose - you or your Playing Partner can <u>SEND message to the manager</u> either noting your TEAM PAIRING and/or include any special requests for early or late in your message.

Step 4. Hit the SEND button.

The tee sheet link in Golf Genius will populate names for the confirmed list of players. Pairings will not appear until TEAMS are made on the back end in Golf Genius. As always, be assured we will monitor signups closely and communicate with you if there are any issues. Registered players should get a Golf Genius automated signup confirmation email.

If you are a single with no partner, please sign up as a single making a note in Golf Genius to the manager and we will try our best to pair you up with another single. Remember that we cap our tournament size and will place players/teams on a waitlist if reached. If you're lost in the signup process, or need any assistance please communicate with us.

Helpful hint: For our July 15th Invitation tournament - AB flights will be on Chino Creek and CD flights will be on Butterfield.
