#### Nebraska K-12 Technology Scope and Sequence

Have you ever wondered what technology knowledge and skills students should have at each grade level? This summer a group of teachers developed a technology scope and sequence for grades K-12. This document is broken up into seven areas (Basic Technology, Productivity Application/Tools, Digital Media, Digital Citizenship, Research, Communications/Collaboration, and Computer Science/Programming).

The standards in the document do not replace the 7-12 grade Communication and Information Systems course standards. This document was developed to provide school districts with a guide for when to teach technology knowledge and skills.

### Nebraska FBLA Recognizes State Award Winners






