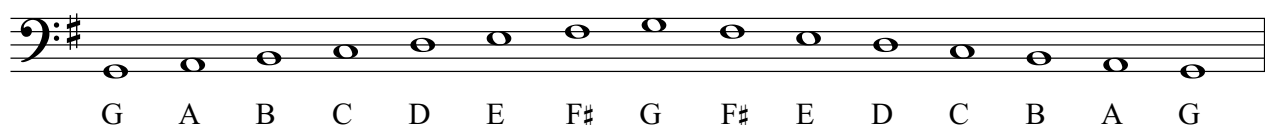

1. a) e minor *harmonic*



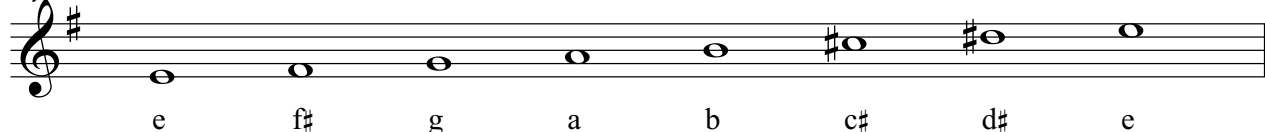
1. b) RELATIVE major: G

2. a) e minor *melodic* from Tonic to Tonic

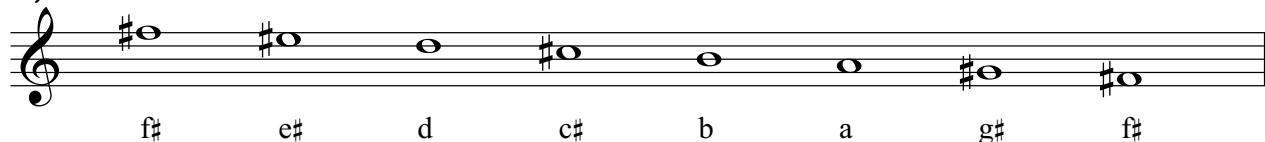


2. b) a minor *natural* from Dominant to Dominant

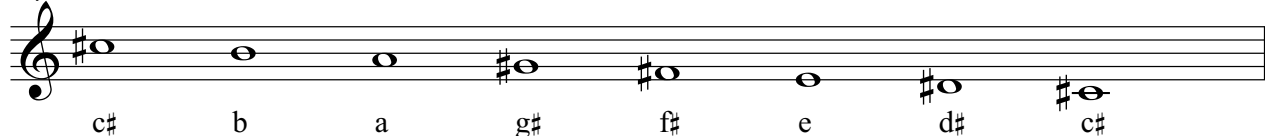

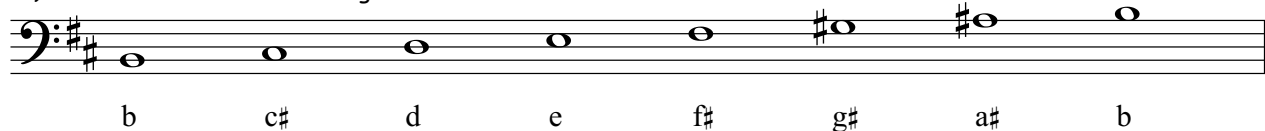

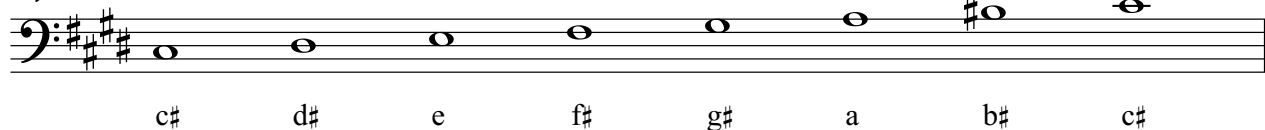

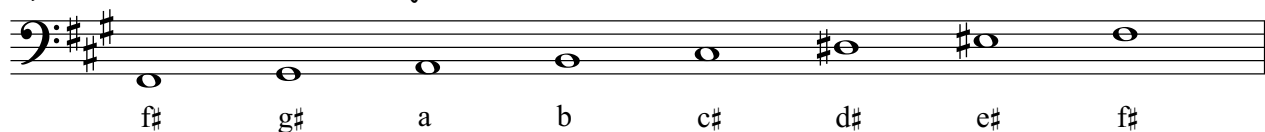
2. a) *melodic* minor whose leading note is a#: b minor
