To the Sherburn and Welcome City Councils,

The department logged 135 calls for service for the month of April. This was up from 2010 and 2009 for the same period. Overall, the department is up over the last two years for call by a considerable number during the first four months.

The department's annual Law Enforcement Memorial Week event was held again at the Sherburn Elementary School. Each agency in the county was represented again this year and we also paid tribute to the National Guard members from this area that will be deploying on May 15th. The kids had a great time as well as the officers that were present.

There will be a parade for the National Guard send off at 12:00 PM in Fairmont. The parade route is from the mall to the Lake Avenue Bridge. The department will assist with traffic and each law enforcement and fire department in the county will have a vehicle in the parade. I hope you can make it if you have time.
