

Audition for this course by attending an audition day workshop (a non-refundable audition registration fee applies). You should deliver two dance pieces of at least 90 seconds in length. They should be in contrasting styles of dance to show your strengths.

International students who cannot attend the audition day workshop can audition via DVD/Video/YouTube. This must be submitted with your application form. Following this you may also be asked to attend a Skype interview as well.
