~ THE MONTH OF JULY ~ Transformed: My Life in God's Kingdom Transformers impact our lives every day – ...and we never think about it!

Before electricity comes into your house, it first must pass through a transformer to lower the voltage. You likely have several transformers even inside your house. Computers and chargers often have transformer boxes attached to their power cords, reducing the voltage even further. Too much power can destroy appliances and gadgets. Our lives often experience the opposite. We don't have enough power – if we have any at all. While some electrical transformers are able to boost electrical power, we unfortunately can't manufacture anything like that to increase the power in our own lives.

But Jesus can. Matthew 6-7 is a part of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, a sermon that shows us the path to transformation. When we live in Him and apply His teachings to our lives, we are truly transformed and empowered. Jesus connected our relationship to God and His Kingdom to every aspect of life. In other words, a relationship with Jesus doesn't just transform us spiritually; it transforms every part of our lives, and gives us the power to live daily for Him.
