Take a look at a play and consider the no-call on the blocked shot and which official should be making this call. <u>Here</u> it is.

So the call...no foul was ruled on the play...the coach seems to indicate a push from behind.......Lead had a great look at it, was focused on the play and even appears to look up at potential body then arm contact. I have to trust him and also that he did NOT anticipate the call! Correct no-call from lead!

Was this leads call? Center? Trail? Well I hope we can agree that C needs to stay off of it (or T in a 2-person game). T on this play? The pass came from T but after white receives it, he gains position on the inside of blue – T would be guessing with any whistle because he would be straight-lined. I say this play is L 100% and we will trust him on it! He has a GREAT angle and look at it!

Tuesday Extra: When you have the captain's meeting before a game, the R should ask the table to take care of turning music down so that the R doesn't need to yell during the meeting! Remember that the R stands closest to center court facing the table and partner(s) included in the 'circle' on the table side looking out/across the meeting at the teams warming up. Make sure the sportsmanship message is read and a captains meeting held for EVERY game at EVERY level!
