Cleveland-Cliffs to Acquire U.S. Assets of ArcelorMittal

Cleveland-Cliffs has announced that they have agreed to acquire ArcelorMittal USA.

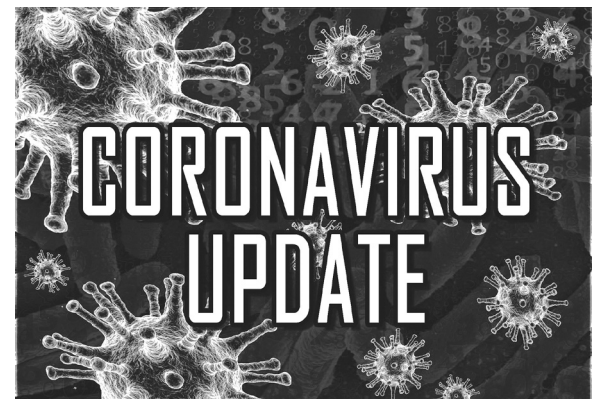
The transaction is scheduled to be completed during the fourth quarter of 2020, and until then the two entities will operate as separate companies.

“This is an exciting time for Cleveland-Cliffs and the North American steel industry,” said R. Christopher Cebula, Senior VP/Chief Administration Officer at Cliffs.

Once completed, the \$1.4 billion deal will make Cliffs the largest flat-rolled steel producer in the country. They are already recognized as the largest iron ore pellet producer in North America, with an estimated 28 million ton annual capacity.

Covid-19 Surging Around the Arrowhead: Testing Efforts Increased

Cases in the Arrowhead are increasing steadily, while cases in St. Louis County are surging, especially in congregate care settings. St. Louis County has had repeated days of new record high numbers of new cases, with their highest number of current active cases to date.

From a WTIP radio report: As of September 28th Cook County Public Health Supervisor Grace Grainger reported another new case of Covid-19 in that county, bringing their total to 8 cases. One case in the Cook County School District has been reported.

In Lake County total cases are 61, adding three more cases in the last week. Five cases are currently “active”, while the rest are recovered.

Throughout the state Minnesota's infection rate has increased to 1.17 percent, indicating a speeding up in the rate of transmission over previous months, and a positive test rate of 8.8% (anything over 5% is considered “too high”). Wisconsin's positive test rate is currently 18.8%.

- Drive-through testing in Ely is free to anyone (symptoms or no symptoms) on Tuesday, October 6 at the St. Louis Public Works Facility on Sheridan Street. No insurance or ID is required, and area residents needing free transportation can call: 9218)741-7380.
- Saliva testing at the DECC in Duluth is available to anyone, with or without symptoms, and results come back in 48-72 hours. No insurance or ID required. Over 2,000 tests have already been completed there. Hours are Wednesday through Friday from noon to 7:00pm, Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am to 4:00pm.
