History Lesson for the Month of October:

October 1, 1908 - Henry Ford's Model T, a "Universal Car" designed for the masses, went on sale for the first time.

October 1, 1979 - After 70 years of American control, the Panama Canal was formally handed over to Panama.

October 2, 1968 - California's Redwood National Park was established.

October 2, 1975 - Japanese Emperor Hirohito Moto made his first-ever visit to the White House.

October 3, 1863 - President Abraham Lincoln issued a proclamation designating the last Thursday in November as Thanksgiving Day.

October 3, 1974 - Frank Robinson was hired by the Cleveland Indians as baseball's first African American Major League manager.

October 3, 1970 - After 45 years of Cold War Division, East and West Germany were reunited as the Federal Republic of Germany.

October 5, 1964 - The largest mass escape since the construction of the Berlin Wall occurred as 57 East German refugees escaped to West Berlin after tunneling beneath the Wall.

October 8, 1871 - The Great Chicago Fire erupted.

October 8, 1890 - American ace fighter pilot Eddie Rickenbacker was born in Columbus, Ohio.

October 9, 1940 - Beatle John Lennon was born in Liverpool, England.

October 10, 1973 - Vice President Spiro T. Agnew resigned.

October 11, 1884 - Eleanor Roosevelt was born in New York City.

October 12, 1492 - After a 33-day voyage, Christopher Columbus made his first land fall in the New World in the Bahamas.

October 13, 1775 - (FOR OUR NAVY VETERANS) The United States Navy was born after the Second Continental Congress authorized the acquisition of a fleet of ships.

October 13, 1792 - The cornerstone of the White House was laid by George Washington.

October 13, 1884 - Greenwich was established as the universal time from which standard time throughout the world is calculated.

October 14, 1947 - U.S. Air Force Captain Chuck Yeager became the first man to break the sound barrier flying in a rocket-powered research aircraft.
