From the Underground Railroad, to the National Road ... from the riverways, to the byways ... for the young and old and everyone in between, the Washington County Historical Society (WCHS) transports members through yesterday's proud heritage and rich history to tomorrow's bright future.

The WCHS administers the *LeMoyne House*, the first National Historic Landmark of the Underground Railroad in Pennsylvania, home to both the *Military Heritage Museum* and the *Civil War Room*. The society also administers and maintains the *LeMoyne Crematory*, the first crematory in the western hemisphere, and the beautiful and historic *Madeleine's Garden* adjacent to the LeMoyne House.

The Frontier History Center, the society's latest project, with its early frontier settlement, is being developed at Washington Park. Stage one has been completed. Future plans call for the addition of a meeting house/ trading post, two more cabins, a barn and an Indian settlement area.

In 2006, the Historical Society purchased the former *Dr. John LeMoyne property* located directly across the street from the first LeMoyne House.

Upon completion, this site will be used for the historical society's administrative and educational activities. Future development also includes the construction of a *Washington County History Museum*.

As one of its primary missions, the Washington County Historical Society conducts free educational programs in classrooms and with organizations throughout the county and supports adult special interests through our education programming. These endeavors are designed to promote interest and pride in Washington County's past as well as to help educate the public about this county's rich, proud history and national significance.
