The museum is still open by appointment ANY TIME if you'd like to look around or do some research

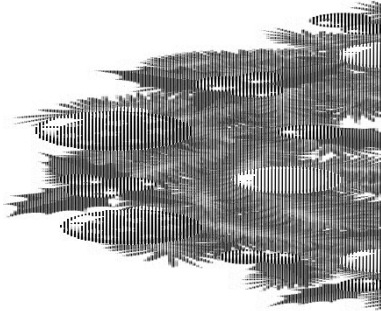
