SOMMITÀ PINOT NOIR  
2012 MARIN COUNTY ESTATE

*The 2012 vintage introduces our Sommità Pinot Noir. Sommità translates to “Summit” in Italian. A fitting name as our vineyards are located at the “Summit” or “Crown” of the Skywalker Ranch which is nestled in the heart of Marin County. Visually the 2012 Sommità Pinot Noir offers deep ruby color with a waning purple edge telltale of ripe, but not over-ripe, Pinot Noir from a cool location. Highly aromatic with clove, warm forest berries like raspberries and blueberries, that leads towards a spicy and red fruit center. Texturally coating and lavish on the palate but remains firm with bright Marin County acidity on the finish. Very primary upon release and will develop added layers and complexity with bottle aging. Cellared in ideal environment that allowed for the wine to be bottled without any fining or filtration.*

The harvest season of 2012 will be remembered for its bountiful blue skies and mild temperatures. Considered a classic vintage with respect to all varieties on the estate, the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay reached ideal ripeness without threat of rain or damaging conditions. The Pinot Noir harvest was in late September followed three and a half weeks later with the Chardonnay harvest.

SKYWALKER VINEYARDS  
SOMMITÀ CHARDONNAY  
2014 MARIN COUNTY ESTATE

*The 2014 Skywalker Vineyards Sommità Chardonnay is an unoaked wine that captures the bright, fruit-forward flavors of Marin County Chardonnay. Without the influence of oak, it allows the true characteristics of the Chardonnay varietal to rise to the top. You notice the aromatics of tropical fruit such as pineapple and guava blossom on your initial pass. The flavors of green apple, pear and citrus come out with your first taste. The finish has a clean minerality and invites you back for another sip.*

Sommità Chardonnay is planted at a 950 foot elevation on the Summit of the Skywalker Ranch property. Growing Chardonnay in this area allows us to leave the grapes on the vine up to 30 days longer than most Chardonnay producers. By doing this, the vine has more time to allow the seed to fully mature. The 2014 growing season was mild and we continued to see little to no rain after the flowering. This temperate fall climate gave the grapes a consistent luxurious season to develop the finest flavors.
