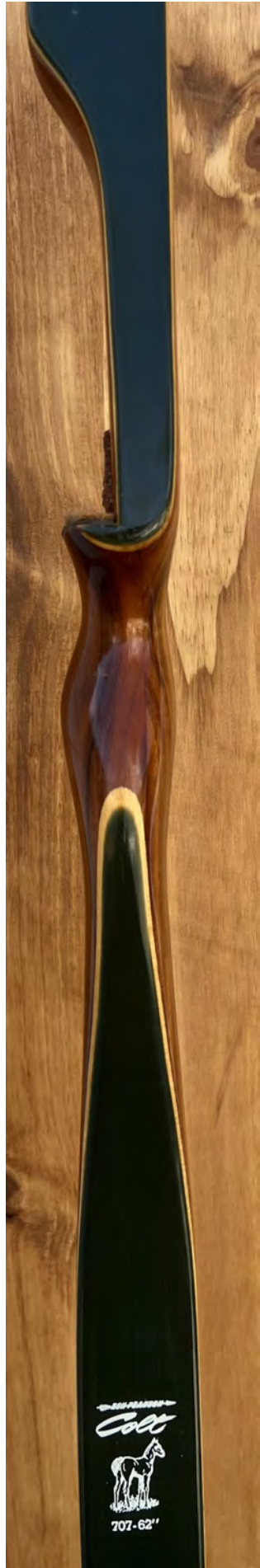

DESCRIPTION: This Colt is in amazing shape for its age. Great looking and performing recurve. I have owned many Colts over the years, and for an economical bow, it performs very well. This one is an exceptional shooter, rivaling some of my high-end bows. It is rare to find a Colt model with a 51# hunting weight and green limbs. This one has an attractive Olla riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. I added tip overlays to beautify and strength the limb tips. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate as shown, and a new string.
