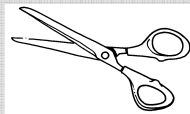

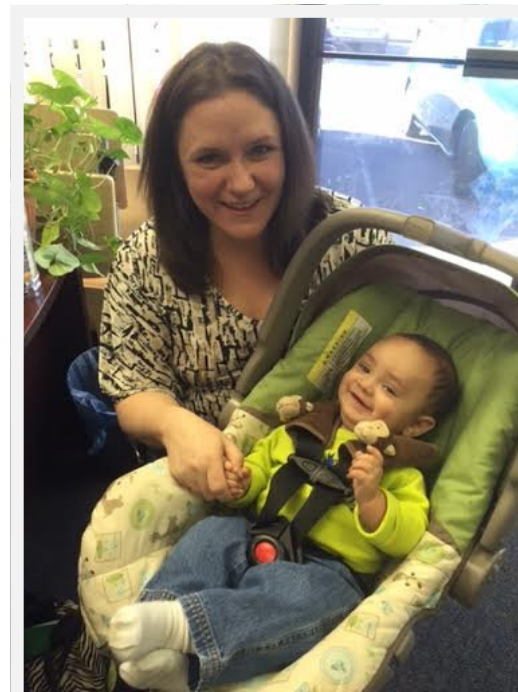
# *The Many Faces of Motherhood*

Isaiah was not a planned pregnancy but Mandy couldn't be more devoted to motherhood. Six months old now, Isaiah's face breaks into a smile whenever Mom or big brother walks into the room. Even though Mandy is an experienced mother she loves attending Hope House classes because she feels you can never learn too much when it comes to taking care of babies. The diapers and wipes she receives for attending classes has really helped her make ends meet as she has yet been able to return to work.

Melissa and Ayeleonna, on the other hand, are still high school students at Dobyns Bennett. Experiencing pregnancy for the first time and nervous about being moms, they took time to attend Hope House "Moms2B" sessions after school at DB-- learning about healthy pregnancy, childbirth, and setting goals for their futures. They attended the annual TTOPS (Teaching Teens Outstanding Parenting Skills) Conference at Celebration Church hosted by the Sullivan County Health Department and a collaboration of other agencies such as Hope House. This year, Hope House offered two break-out sessions on Positive Parenting and Healthy Child Discipline.

Ashley, (*featured on front page*) was the TTOPS keynote speaker. She shared her life with pregnant teens and teen parents from our area high schools that with determination, hard work, and a good support system, there is always hope for a bright future!
