NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON JULY 13, 2010 AT 7:00 PM TO AMEND OUR LOCAL JUNK YARD ORDINANCE DATED 11/6/1967 TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING.

AMENDED ORDINANCE (Amending Ordinance date, November 6,1967)

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A Local Ordinance Providing for Licensing and Regulating Automobile Junk Yards in the Town of Wilmington, Essex County, New York

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Wilmington, Essex County, New York as follows:

This Amendment to the aforementioned Ordinance shall include revisions to Section 2: Definitions and Section 3: Requirement for Operation or Maintenance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

Junked Vehicles means any motor vehicles whether automobile, bus, trailer, truck, tractor, motor home, motorcycle, mini bicycle, snowmobile, all terrain vehicle, go-cart, bicycle, golf cart, lawn tractor, boat, snow blower, lawn mower, travel trailer, camper, or any other pieced machinery originally intended for travel on the public highways which (1) is unlicensed, wrecked, stored, discarded or dismantled or partly dismantled; which is not intended or in any condition for legal use upon the public highway and (2) is in such condition as to cost more to repair and place in operating condition than it's reasonable market value at that time before such repair. With respect to any motor vehicle not required to be licensed or motor vehicle not usually used on public highways, the fact that such motor vehicle has remained unused for more then six (6) months and is not in condition to be removed under its own power, shall be presumptive evidence that such motor vehicle is a "junk motor vehicle".

SECTION 3: REQUIREMENT FOR OPERATION OR MAINTENANCE

<u>Individual Junk Vehicles</u> No individual junk vehicle, as that term is defined herein, may be located so as to be visible from public roads, trails, boat or canoe routes, or from neighboring properties for a period of greater then six (6) months, in the event that a junk vehicle is visible from these areas, the junk vehicle must be removed within ten (10) days of receiving notice from an authorized officer of the Town of Wilmington.

Anyone in violation of this Section 3 shall be subject to the same penalties as set forth in Section 13 of the original Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ENTEND THAT: All other provisions of the original Ordinance regarding this Licensing and Regulations of Automobile Junk Yards, dated November 6, 1967 shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication and posting of said Ordinance pursuant to applicable Section of Town Law.
