 - 10263 remove Juniper - replacement TBD.
 - 10265 remove Juniper and overgrown Gardenia Bush - replacement TBD.
 - 10267 remove Juniper - replacement TBD.
 - 10274 remove Iris's and replace with Lirope.
 - 10252 Replace large plants- one that is approaching soffit with large roots near the home foundation and another that is growing into their neighbor's space and has sharp needles at the tip.
 - 10222 trim overgrown Rubber Tree and Palm bush.
 - 10204 remove Juniper and Flax plant - - replacement TBD.
