#### NOTES

**BRING – NWUs (Blouse, blue t-shirt, trousers, black belt w/silver buckle, black boots socks, black boots w/blousing straps), HYDRATION, ASSIGNMENTS, PACKED LUNCH.**

1. Be sure to bring ALL components to the designated uniforms, your shoe shining kit, notebook and writing utensil. Bring proper hydration (black canteen & web belt; all black camelback or water bottle).
2. UNIFORMS – Getting your uniform ready is an important part of preparing for drill. This includes ironing your clothes, shining your shoes/boots, sewing on the proper patches, and ensuring your hair meets the required guidelines.
3. ATTENDANCE – NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. This amounts to a total absence allowance of five (5) drills per school year. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC/NLCC.
4. CORRESPONDENCE COURSES – All NSCC Cadets are required to turn in at least two (2) BMRs or one (1) coursework assignment per drill. See your Petty Officer if you have any questions.
