History:

Ridgestock began in 2000 as a grass roots effort to showcase local music and green living in our area. Over the years the festival has grown substantially and is now a mainstay of the summer in the foothills. 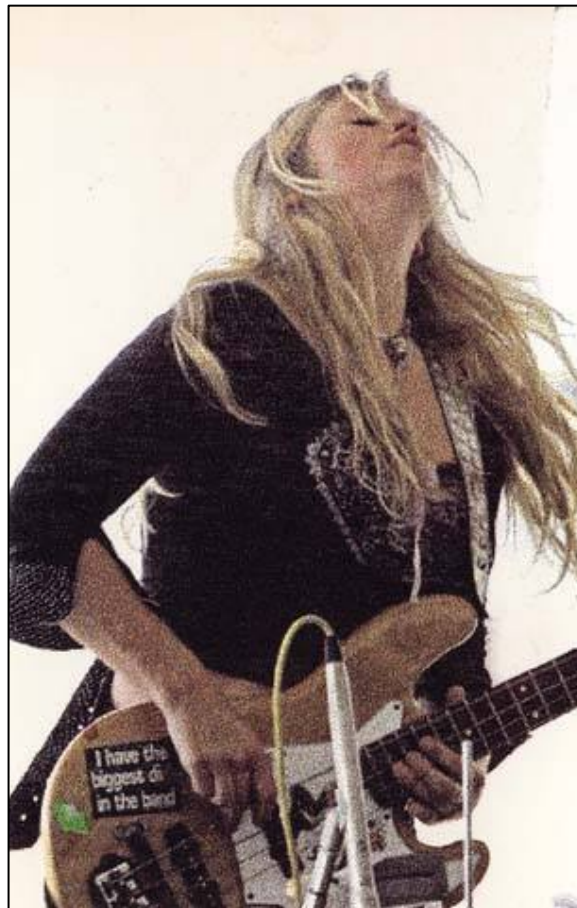
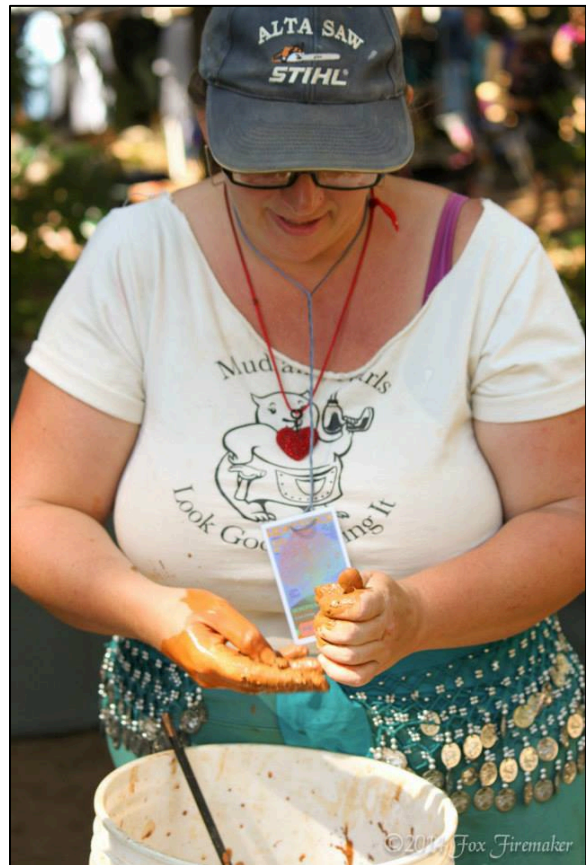
