School Age Programs (Ages 6-17)

Session I: MUSICAL THEATRE July 1st-12th Ages 6-14

Mon-Fri - 9am-4pm Students train in singing, dancing and acting and will perform in a PILOT PRODUCTION of Disney's FINDING NEMO Kids, the musical! Camp takes place at *On Your Toes Dance Studio*
No camp on 7/4. Tech Rehearsal on 7/10 & 7/11 from 5-7pm. Performances 7/12 at 6pm, 7/13 at 2pm & 6pm and 7/14 at 2pm. **Tuition: \$595**

Session II: TUMBLE & CHEER July 15th-26th Ages 6-14

Mon-Fri - 9am-4pm Students will gain flexibility, strength and coordination as well as confidence through our most popular fitness and performance program. Tumbling is offered every day in addition to develop cheer and dance skills. Camp takes place at *On Your Toes Dance Studio*. Tumble and Cheer Showcase on July 27th at St. Mark's Gym. Rehearsal 10am-12:30pm. Show-off at 1pm. **Tuition: \$525**

Session III: VOCAL ARTS July 29th-August 2nd Ages 6-14

Mon-Fri - 9am-4pm Students will develop confidence in their singing and speaking skills while learning different musical styles, understanding basic music theory and developing their own performance piece. Students will have a culminating recital in NYC. Camp takes place at *On Your Toes Dance Studio*. Tech Rehearsal on 8/4 at 12pm in NYC. Performance at Don't Tell Mama Piano Bar on 8/4 at 3pm. **Tuition: \$225**

Session IV: *NYC ADVANCED MUSICAL THEATRE August 12th-16th in NYC! Ages 8-17

Mon-Fri 9am-4pm Make your off-Broadway debut! Perform in a musical NYC's Theatre District! Students will audition by appointment during the weekend before camp. Students will receive intensive training with professional teaching artists in music, choreography and performance while rehearsing and producing a **musical (title is TBA)**. Camp and production at *Shetler Studios: 244 W. 54th St. New York, NY 10019*. Auditions by appt: August 9th, 10th, 11th by appt. All registered students will be cast with an opportunity to perform a featured singing, dancing or acting role. Limited spaces. Daily transportation chaperone available for students taking the subway from the Bronx may be available. Ask for details. **Tuition: \$475**

Mon-Fri from 9am-12pm. This is an ideal first-time drop-off program for little ones who will enter a pre-k or pre-k preparatory program for the first time. We practice gentle separation techniques and offer a variety of student driven activities to help students begin to develop the social, emotional, cognitive and physical skills to set them up for success in school. Founded in 2013, New York All Stars is a unique enrichment program with a mission to promote skills for leadership and success through fitness and performing arts programming. Our award-winning program offers unmatched opportunities to train in performance-based athletics and incredible events throughout the year. Our students have been featured at the Barclay's Center with Camp Broadway, On stage at Radio City Music Hall, Off-Broadway, and before a Mets Game at CitiField. Additionally, we have competed throughout the tri-state area, earning national recognition; and traveled to the Junior Theatre Festival in Atlanta, GA with our award winning P.O.P.S. Team. NYAS prioritizes introducing these skills to the very young and introduces programming for students as young as 2.5. Our enrichment classes and teams are appropriate for all ability levels from ages 6-14. We also offer advanced level training and internship programs for teens who continue with the program.



About our Summer Programs:

Summer Programs have always been a staple in our season and are open to current members and non-members. Our camps attract students from within our program but are also a great opportunity for those traveling to NY during the summer. They are a great way to hone skills for the new season and to try our program's offerings before committing. This year, we are offering more exciting opportunities than ever before! Each of our school age summer programs will have a culminating performance! We are delighted to be selected by Disney Theatrical Group to present a pilot production of Disney's Finding Nemo KIDS – a new 30-minute musical created for student performers. Our Tumble and Cheer Camp will have an end of camp Showcase on Saturday, July 27th. The Vocal Arts Camp takes place in Yonkers but will perform in NYC on one day only. The Advanced Musical Theatre Camp will offer students the unique experience of rehearsing and producing a show in New York City!

Who should attend?

Our early childhood programs and Sessions I, II and III are ideal for any student who is age appropriate, regardless of their ability or experience. Session IV is dedicated to students who are serious and passionate about learning about the professional industry of musical theatre performance. Previous experience is not required, but helpful.



What to bring:

Each day, all campers should bring a small, labeled bag with a bottle of water. Water will be available for \$1.00 and billed to your account on days that water is not sent with your child.

Early Childhood Program: Please provide a daily take home folder for arts and crafts. Please do not send toys from home and be sure to label everything. Please send water every day. Please send a healthy snack. Students should wear comfortable clothing and sneakers. No open toed shoes. Shorts should be worn under dresses.

School Age Program: All campers will receive details regarding needs for their specific camp. For most, dance or athletic wear is required. Hair must be up in a pony tail or bun. Dance or cheer shoes are required for most activities involving movement and should be brought in a bag each day. Females should wear a leotard, sports bra or tightly fitting tank top under loose tops. Please provide a lunch each day that is NUT FREE and does not require refrigeration or microwaving.

Guidelines

1. Tuition must be paid in full to complete your registration no later than May 1st. Your space will not be held for more than 48 hours without a \$100 deposit per session. Please read our full payment policies on the last page of this packet.
2. Please send your child with a water bottle every day. Water is the ONLY beverage allowed at New York All Stars. New York All Stars will sell water for \$1.00 per bottle. This will be billed to your account if your child arrives without water.
3. All classes are drop-off only. Due to limited space, there are no observers. Please drop off and pick up no more than 10 minutes before the class start time and finish time. NOTE: Late pick-up fee of \$25 is billed to your account if you are more than 15 minutes picking up and we cannot reach you. If you are late and cannot be reached for more than 30 minutes, the police may be called. Please always communicate if you are running late.
4. **What to wear:** Dance or athletic clothes for most of our classes with hair up and out of the face. Dance and musical theatre classes require jazz shoes or ballet slippers. No street clothes including jeans, jewelry or open toed shoes in ANY movement or tumbling class. We strongly



recommend wearing New York All Stars licensed apparel to ensure your child is easily recognizable as our student in the event of an emergency.

5. During classes: No food, No Gum, No Phones.

6. Zero tolerance for abusive language, action or behavior toward any student, parent or employee. Concerns should be addressed privately and in a professional manner. We strive to meet your needs and will always work together toward a solution. Please do not address concerns while other campers and clients are present. You can e-mail or call us to arrange a private meeting.

7. No side-coaching. Please do not instruct your child during classes or performances.

8. Save training for class time. **Trying skills at home without the supervision and critique of a qualified coach is not only dangerous but creates bad habits.** Your child should progress at their own pace and the best way to work at home is to prepare the body for each class – stretch, rest, drink water, eat well. Our instructors are happy to provide you with tips for practicing between classes.

9. Attendance is necessary for the successful execution of our daily plans and performances. Please let us know if you will miss a day, need to leave early or arrive late. Excessive absences can affect a child's role if there is a performance. There are no refunds if you are absent. Extended absences (3+ days) or missing a session all together due to illness or emergency may be considerations for a tuition credit, but there are no refunds.

10. NYAS is an inclusive program and will always make an effort to accommodate students with learning differences or physical conditions, however we require clear communication of your child's condition and needs. Please clarify any special needs upon registration to ensure we are properly prepared to instruct your child. We reserve the right to remove any child from camp whose needs are not communicated prior and/or for whom we are not equipped to accommodate. This is in the best interest of all campers and staff.

11. CASTING: For performance-based camps, all registered members will be cast. Casting is final and non-negotiable.

12. Early Childhood students must be fully toilet trained.

12. Campers are required to have medical insurance and must provide a contact phone number for the child's primary care physician. Parents who register agree to our medical liability waiver and photo/video waiver. Campers may not register without parental acceptance of both.



Fee Schedule and Payment Policy:

DUE UPON REGISTRATION: \$100 Deposit **per session you will attend:** This deposit is deducted from your total charge. It is non-refundable and holds your place in our Summer Program.

Your remaining balance can be broken into a maximum of 3 equal payments due:

March 1st, April 1st and May 1st.

Discounts

There is a 10% discount when your full camp tuition payment is received by April 1st.

There is a 15% discount when your full camp tuition payment is received by March 1st.

Sibling / Multi-child discount: 10% *Can only be used by immediate family members on the same billing account.

Refund policy: Your deposit and a \$150 cancelation fee are deducted if you withdraw before May 1st. Any additional fees paid will be refunded or credited to your New York All Stars account. There are no refunds after May 1st. If you opt for a refund instead of a credit, you may not participate in New York All Stars programs for one calendar year. Credits are non-refundable but do not expire and can be used on tuition for any future class.

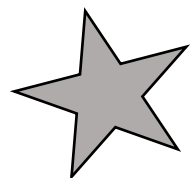
