Southern Maine Seacoast Tour

September 9-12, 2019

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2019

7:00am Depart JORDAN ELBRIDGE COMMUNITY CENTER Jordan, NY

(stops will be made for breakfast, and lunch along the way)

3:30pm Approximate arrival time to Maine, the “Pine Tree” state! Arrive in PORTLAND, Maine’s largest city-by-the-sea. Check in for a three-night stay at CLARION HOTEL PORTLAND. This full-service hotel is located 1 mile from the waterfront with indoor pool, restaurant and lounge.

A WELCOME RECEPTION is provided upon arrival with a souvenir lobster hat for each passenger.

BUFFET DINNER will be served in a private room at the hotel, followed by an ENTERTAINMENT program (tentatively Musingo, a toe-tapping, multi-media program featuring favorites from the 50’s and 60’s. Can you name that tune? Now check your bingo card to see if you have the performer listed.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2019

After a hot BUFFET BREAKFAST, meet your LOCAL GUIDE for a full day touring PORTLAND and KENNEBUNKPORT.

Your tour will include views of Portland sea captain’s homes, the elegant Victoria Mansion and Longfellow’s boyhood home as you drive through historic neighborhoods overlooking the islands of Casco Bay. Your tour includes a stop at PORTLAND HEAD LIGHTHOUSE. This historic landmark is the most photographed lighthouse in America, set in Fort Williams Park.

-Motorcoach permit for the park is included in tour package. You will have a bit of free time to explore the Old Port waterfront district with shops and galleries after the tour.

Travel south to KENNEBUNKPORT for lunch on your own in Dock Square. Your guide will point out restaurants within easy walking distance and coach parking is included.

This afternoon you will tour the highlights of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport, two shipbuilding villages on Maine’s south coast. Learn the history and folklore as you drive past the beaches, hear the legend of the Wedding Cake House and maritime history of sea captains and shipbuilders. You will travel through the port and along Ocean Avenue, past the Bush summer home at Walker’s Point with a stop at the FRANCISCAN MONASTERY with its seaside shrines and gardens.



You’ve heard of chocolate mousse, but have you ever seen a chocolate moose? On the way back to the hotel, enjoy a moose pop treat bag with Lenny the Chocolate Moose. Have your photo taken with Lenny and friends and learn how the 1700-pound life-size chocolate moose was created by Len Libby’s candy makers.

Freshen up for a DINNER included this evening (tentatively at DiMillo’s Waterfront Restaurant, in the heart of the Old Port).
