First I want to thank everyone that attended the installation of your 2016-2017 Department officers on Sunday at the State Convention at the Care Free Resort. I am truly honored to be your Department of Arizona President for 2016-2017. As we start a new year I hope you are excited about it as I am and all the great things Arizona will accomplish this year.

By the time you read this the Officers/Chairman Workshop was held on July 9, 2016 at Post 29 in Glendale. I want to thank everyone that attended, you have a great TEAM guiding you this year, now we need to roll up our sleeves and start working all our programs.

As you know my Special Project this year is Soldiers Best Friend and my theme is "Paws in Service" for our Veterans and their Families. Just What Is Americanism?

According to The American Legion Auxiliary

Americanism and the 2014-2019 Centennial Strategic Plan – Promoting patriotism and responsible citizenship help us fulfill our brand promise (*Goal 5) by giving U.S. citizens a chance to participate in our mission by feeling patriotic and demonstrating their support in an active, visible way. Teaching our country's most promising young citizens firsthand the principles of our free republic guided by the principles of democracy, the Auxiliary promotes many patriotic youth programs, including the Auxiliary-sponsored Americanism Essay Contest, which is conducted in local school systems.

According to Wikipedia:

Americanism "is an articulation of the [United States of America's] rightful place in the world, a set of traditions, a political language, and a cultural style imbued with political meaning. According The American Legion (a U.S. veterans' organization), Americanism is an ideology or belief in devotion, loyalty, or allegiance to the United States of America or to its flag, traditions, customs, culture, symbols, institutions, or form of government".

I was amazed that The American Legion was referenced in this description. The American Legion is a force to be reckoned with and so are we. We just need to get our name "The American Legion Auxiliary" out there.

We can to this by standing up for our American Flag and what it represents. If you see a discolored, tattered or a flag looking in distress, at stores, apartment complexes, buildings, homes, etc., politely ask the manager or owner to please replace the flag as soon as possible. Check back later to see if it was taken care of.

Did you know that Wikipedia displays Historical progression of the American Flag? There is a table depicting the 28 various designs of the United States flag, the star patterns for the flags are merely the *usual* patterns, often associated with the United States Navy. Canton designs, prior to the proclamation of the 48-star flag, had no official arrangement of the stars. Furthermore, the exact *colors* of the flag were not standardized until 1934 and has remained the same to this date. If you get a chance take a look for yourselves.

During the summer months make plans to conduct a flag disposal ceremony, assemble pocket flags, prepare a list of patriotic holidays and get ready to celebrate and work together with your Legion family.

At Fall Conference in November, an Americanism packet will be placed in your Unit's mailbox and should be picked up by your Unit President or representative. Make sure you asked for this packet at your next meeting after Conference. Inside you will find helpful information and guidelines for a successful Americanism program.

SUBJECT: DUES, MANDATES, FEES, DONATIONS, ETC.

The following are program funds that need to go through the Department Books. Checks are to be made payable and sent to American Legion Auxiliary, 4701 N. 19th Ave. Suite 100, Phoenix AZ 85015-3727. Please write separate checks for MEMBERSHIP, and Mandates. All others may be included in one check with an explanation as to where the funds are being donated to.

REMINDER: ALL MANDATES ARE DUE 30 DAYS PRIOR TO CONVENTION OR YOUR UNIT WILL FOREFIT IT'S RIGHT TO VOTE. DO NOT SEND DISTRICT MANDATES TO DEPARTMENT, SEND THEM TO YOUR DISTRICT.....

- DUES:Current and previous years dues are \$16.00 per Senior and \$4.00 per Junior. This includes
Department and National dues. It also includes a subscription to the National News
magazine for senior member.
- <u>MANDATES</u>: 2016 Department Close of Books membership totals are used to determine the base for assessments District AND Department. Rehabilitation Per Capita (RPC) is twenty cents per <u>SENIOR</u> member. (RPC is sent on to National for their use in veterans programs.)
 Delegate Per Capita (DPC) is twenty cents per member, <u>SENIORS</u>. (DPC is used by the Department to send delegates to National Convention.) Junior Activities Per Capita (JAPC) is twenty cents per member, <u>JUNIOR AND SENIOR</u>, and is paid whether or not your Unit has any Juniors. This is used to send Junior President and Chaperon to Junior National Convention. Junior Delegate Per Capita (JDPC) is twenty cents per junior member and is used by the Department to support the Junior Activities Fund. Blanket Position BOND covers all Unit members, and is forwarded to National yearly. Bond fee per Unit is \$5.50.
- POPPIES:Units are urged to order poppies. Poppies are \$120.00 per thousand and can be ordered
in increments of 100 (\$12.00 per hundred). Poppies must be ordered by September 30,
2015. Please use the enclosed form to order poppies. Units must order at least 100 poppies
to compete for Department Awards except membership. After Poppy Distribution is
completed, 10% of NET Poppy proceeds are to be sent to Department. Poppy Funds are
restricted funds see the Guide for Volunteers for explanation.
- **WELFARE PLEDGE**: This money stays in Department for use in the Welfare Budget for Veterans programs and direct aid.
- <u>CHRISTMAS PLEDGE</u>: This money stays in Department for use in the Welfare Budget for each VA Medical Center (VAMC) in Arizona to place dollar bills in Christmas Cards for the hospitalized veterans. It's just a small gift, but is very much appreciated.

HOSPITAL PARTIES &

- **SOCIAL SERVICES:** This money is sent to the VAMC's as designated by Units for monthly Bingo Parties, comfort items, recreation & medical equipment, carnivals, etc.
- **<u>GIFT SHOP</u>**: Money is used for purchasing gifts that enable hospitalized veterans to pick out gifts (free of charge) for themselves and their families to celebrate the Christmas Holiday.

PAST PRESIDENT'S

- PARLEY:
 This money funds scholarships in nursing and health care occupations for students attending Arizona schools.
- **<u>SPIRIT OF YOUTH</u>**: This money goes to National to for National Scholarships and youth programs.

AUXILIARY EMERGENCY

- FUND:
 This money is sent to National for assistance to Auxiliary members during a personal crisis or natural disaster. Certain Pre-req. are required.
- **JUNIORS**: This money stays in Department and helps pay the way for our Junior representative and her chaperon to attend the National Junior Meeting, as well as, off-setting Department Junior Meeting Expenses.
- <u>GIRLS STATE</u>: Fees are \$200.00 for the Unit and a <u>\$100.00</u> registration fee from the girl total \$300.00. Units are to deposit all monies received for your Girls State program and write one check to cover fee and registration for the girls. <u>Fees must be sent to the Department Girls State</u> <u>Director with delegate and alternate cards, NOT to Department Headquarters</u>. **Donations** to the Girls State fund may be sent to Department Headquarters.

ARIZONA'S COURTESY &

- <u>CAMPAIGN FUND</u>: This money stays in Department to help with expenses when Arizona has a candidate for National Office.
- **DEPARTMENT OFFICE OVERHEAD EXPENSES FUND**: This money stays in Department to help keep the Department Headquarters Office open with proper furniture and equipment, and all expenses incurred.

CAVALCADE OF

<u>MEMORIES</u>: Funds are used to furnish the Cavalcade Room at Headquarters and for supplies and materials needed, such as scrapbooks, binders, framing, etc.

DEPARTMENT PRESIDENT'S

SPECIAL PROJECT: This money is used for the special project of the Department President. This year, the project is "**SOLDIER'S BEST FRIEND**". Look for more information from the Department Chairman.

I look forward to receiving a copy of the minutes of your unit/district meetings so that we can record as complete a history of the year 2016-2017 as possible for posterity.




3 Community Emergency Response Team



It is this chairman's privilege to introduce you to Soldier's Best Friend.

Soldier's Best Friend is an Arizona based program that provides United States military veterans living with combat-related Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) or Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) with Service or Therapeutic Companion Dogs, most of which are rescued from local shelters.

There is <u>no cost to the veteran</u> for the adoption and training. Most veterinary care is offered at reduced or no cost during the training period.

The goal for this year is for each area of the state, northern, southern, central Arizona, to raise enough money to sponsor one pairing of a veteran and dog. The cost for one pair is \$4,000.

Puppy-paw print jars have been distributed to each District to collect change from the units.

This chairman has issued a challenge to all Districts. The District that collects the most money in their jars, per capita, 30 days prior to Convention will receive a surprise from this chairman at Convention - lets here the clang, clang, of change (and paper)! The monies donated through Department from the Units will also count towards the District challenge.
