

First I want to thank everyone that attended the installation of your 2016-2017 Department officers on Sunday at the State Convention at the Care Free Resort. I am truly honored to be your Department of Arizona President for 2016-2017. As we start a new year I hope you are excited about it as I am and all the great things Arizona will accomplish this year.

By the time you read this the Officers/Chairman Workshop was held on July 9, 2016 at Post 29 in Glendale. I want to thank everyone that attended, you have a great TEAM guiding you this year, now we need to roll up our sleeves and start working all our programs.

As you know my Special Project this year is Soldiers Best Friend and my theme is “Paws in Service” for our Veterans and their Families. It is a program that help a veterans diagnosed with combat-related PTSD/TBI, once accepted into their program, the veteran is paired with a rescued dog or their own dog. Together, the veteran/dog team begins training with their professional trainers. Training is designed for a PTSD Service Dog or Therapeutic Companion Dog. The veteran/dog team attends classes twice weekly for approximately 6 months of training and mentoring. Currently, classes/training is offered in Phoenix, Tucson, Flagstaff, Prescott and Sierra Vista. **ALL THE MONIES RAISED STAYS HERE IN ARIZONA.** You will learn more about this in next coming months.

#### **Just What Is Americanism?**

#### **According to The American Legion Auxiliary**

Americanism and the 2014-2019 Centennial Strategic Plan – Promoting patriotism and responsible citizenship help us fulfill our brand promise (\*Goal 5) by giving U.S. citizens a chance to participate in our mission by feeling patriotic and demonstrating their support in an active, visible way. Teaching our country's most promising young citizens firsthand the principles of our free republic guided by the principles of democracy, the Auxiliary promotes many patriotic youth programs, including the Auxiliary-sponsored Americanism Essay Contest, which is conducted in local school systems.

#### **According to Wikipedia:**

**Americanism** “is an articulation of the [United States of America's] rightful place in the world, a set of traditions, a political language, and a cultural style imbued with political meaning. According The American Legion (a U.S. veterans' organization), Americanism is an ideology or belief in devotion, loyalty, or allegiance to the United States of America or to its flag, traditions, customs, culture, symbols, institutions, or form of government”.

I was amazed that The American Legion was referenced in this description. The American Legion is a force to be reckoned with and so are we. We just need to get our name “The American Legion Auxiliary” out there.

We can do this by standing up for our American Flag and what it represents. If you see a discolored, tattered or a flag looking in distress, at stores, apartment complexes, buildings, homes, etc., politely ask the manager or owner to please replace the flag as soon as possible. Check back later to see if it was taken care of.

Did you know that Wikipedia displays Historical progression of the American Flag? There is a table depicting the 28 various designs of the United States flag, the star patterns for the flags are merely the *usual* patterns, often associated with the United States Navy. Canton designs, prior to the proclamation of the 48-star flag, had no official arrangement of the stars. Furthermore, the exact *colors* of the flag were not standardized until 1934 and has remained the same to this date. If you get a chance take a look for yourselves.

During the summer months make plans to conduct a flag disposal ceremony, assemble pocket flags, prepare a list of patriotic holidays and get ready to celebrate and work together with your Legion family.

At Fall Conference in November, an Americanism packet will be placed in your Unit's mailbox and should be picked up by your Unit President or representative. Make sure you asked for this packet at your next meeting after Conference. Inside you will find helpful information and guidelines for a successful Americanism program.

**SUBJECT: DUES, MANDATES, FEES, DONATIONS, ETC.**

The following are program funds that need to go through the Department Books. **Checks are to be made payable and sent to American Legion Auxiliary, 4701 N. 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. Suite 100, Phoenix AZ 85015-3727.** Please write separate checks for MEMBERSHIP, and Mandates. All others may be included in one check with an explanation as to where the funds are being donated to.

**REMINDER: ALL MANDATES ARE DUE 30 DAYS PRIOR TO CONVENTION OR YOUR UNIT WILL FOREFIT IT'S RIGHT TO VOTE. DO NOT SEND DISTRICT MANDATES TO DEPARTMENT, SEND THEM TO YOUR DISTRICT.....**

**DUES:** Current and previous years dues are **\$16.00 per Senior** and **\$4.00 per Junior**. This includes Department and National dues. It also includes a subscription to the *National News* magazine for senior member.

**MANDATES:** 2016 Department Close of Books membership totals are used to determine the base for assessments – District AND Department. **Rehabilitation Per Capita (RPC)** is twenty cents per SENIOR member. (RPC is sent on to National for their use in veterans programs.) **Delegate Per Capita (DPC)** is twenty cents per member, SENIORS. (DPC is used by the Department to send delegates to National Convention.) **Junior Activities Per Capita (JAPC)** is twenty cents per member, JUNIOR AND SENIOR, **and is paid whether or not your Unit has any Juniors**. This is used to send Junior President and Chaperon to Junior National Convention. **Junior Delegate Per Capita (JDPC)** is twenty cents per junior member and is used by the Department to support the Junior Activities Fund. Blanket Position **BOND** covers all Unit members, and is forwarded to National yearly. **Bond fee per Unit is \$5.50.**

**POPPIES:** Units are urged to order poppies. **Poppies are \$120.00 per thousand and can be ordered in increments of 100 (\$12.00 per hundred).** **Poppies must be ordered by September 30, 2015.** Please use the enclosed form to order poppies. Units must order at least 100 poppies to compete for Department Awards except membership. **After Poppy Distribution is completed, 10% of NET Poppy proceeds are to be sent to Department.** Poppy Funds are restricted funds see the *Guide for Volunteers* for explanation.

**WELFARE PLEDGE:** This money stays in Department for use in the Welfare Budget for Veterans programs and direct aid.

**CHRISTMAS PLEDGE:** This money stays in Department for use in the Welfare Budget for each VA Medical Center (VAMC) in Arizona to place dollar bills in Christmas Cards for the hospitalized veterans. It's just a small gift, but is very much appreciated.

**HOSPITAL PARTIES &**

**SOCIAL SERVICES:** This money is sent to the VAMC's as designated by Units for monthly Bingo Parties, comfort items, recreation & medical equipment, carnivals, etc.

**GIFT SHOP:** Money is used for purchasing gifts that enable hospitalized veterans to pick out gifts (free of charge) for themselves and their families to celebrate the Christmas Holiday.

**PAST PRESIDENT'S**

**PARLEY:** This money funds scholarships in nursing and health care occupations for students attending Arizona schools.

**SPIRIT OF YOUTH:** This money goes to National to for National Scholarships and youth programs.

**AUXILIARY EMERGENCY**

**FUND:** This money is sent to National for assistance to Auxiliary members during a personal crisis or natural disaster. Certain Pre-req. are required.

**JUNIORS:** This money stays in Department and helps pay the way for our Junior representative and her chaperon to attend the National Junior Meeting, as well as, off-setting Department Junior Meeting Expenses.

**GIRLS STATE:** Fees are \$200.00 for the Unit and a **\$100.00** registration fee from the girl total \$300.00. Units are to deposit all monies received for your Girls State program and write one check to cover fee and registration for the girls. Fees must be sent to the Department Girls State Director with delegate and alternate cards, NOT to Department Headquarters. **Donations** to the Girls State fund may be sent to Department Headquarters.

**ARIZONA'S COURTESY &**

**CAMPAIGN FUND:** This money stays in Department to help with expenses when Arizona has a candidate for National Office.

**DEPARTMENT OFFICE OVERHEAD EXPENSES FUND:** This money stays in Department to help keep the Department Headquarters Office open with proper furniture and equipment, and all expenses incurred.

**CAVALCADE OF**

**MEMORIES:** Funds are used to furnish the Cavalcade Room at Headquarters and for supplies and materials needed, such as scrapbooks, binders, framing, etc.

**DEPARTMENT PRESIDENT'S**

**SPECIAL PROJECT:** This money is used for the special project of the Department President. This year, the project is **"SOLDIER'S BEST FRIEND"**. Look for more information from the Department Chairman.

Welcome to the wonderful world of learning. Each day all of us learn something new, sometimes just by observing others and what they do. Everything is educational throughout our lives. To this end, all of us must strive to touch the lives of others with our knowledge each and every day. Don't just limit yourselves to children as there are many adults who could use a little help along the way also. Share a recipe, make cookies with your grandchildren; make them smile. Remember, we are just one big family, and families share, so let's share.

The Education Program is merely a guideline for what each Unit wants to accomplish each year with its membership and resources. Think of all of the ways you can assist and then choose which is best for your Unit and its volunteers. Don't look at the Education Program as separate from Americanism or VA&R, Children & Youth, etc.; as parts of all programs are educational. The Poppy Program, learning how to make a poppy and all about the Poppy and its significance is EDUCATIONAL. Look at that, you now have something for both reports!! Americanism Program, you talk about the flag, when and how it should be displayed, and folding of the flag and what the folds mean. Oh My!! You have information for both Americanism and Education. As you contact each school in your area for Girls State, also supply them with the contact information and material for Scholarships, The Essay Contest and Coloring Contest, the Oratorical Contest. Again, you are working two Programs and have information to report for each of them. Isn't this easier than stressing out about how you can work it in? This is how easy it is.

This year's focus will be about promoting education through all the various programs we each work; including the President's Project of "Paws in Service" which partners' canines with veterans who need not only the companionship, but also the service the canine provides with the training received to help this individual get through the day. As we talk about this project, we are educating the public, other members, Legionnaires, etc. When we talk to people about the American Legion Auxiliary and the great work we all do and how we work with veterans, children & youth, etc., we are actually educating them about the organization and what we do and the importance of it. This knowledge will in turn encourage those eligible to become members. Again, we are educating the public. When we talk about the Four Chaplains, Memorial Day, the Poppy, Veterans Day, POW Day or any other important day for veterans, we are educating the public. Everywhere I look, there is EDUCATION!

**AUGUST** – gather school supplies for needy children; have a children's book drive to support your local library or preschool; talk with your schools about doing special cards or short essays in support of the local fireman and police. This year is 15 years since the 2001 attack.

**SEPTEMBER** – remember the local police and fireman with a special ceremony for 9-11 (share the cookies you made with the grandkids and the cards from the school 😊). Don't forget POW day the following week.

We personally want to thank everyone in advance for being a volunteer and sharing your knowledge with others; and this committee looks forward to a successful and enjoyable year reviewing together all the ways we can report under the Educational Program. We look forward to sharing our ideas and passing along all of yours while working with all the Units in the Department of Arizona. 

Hello Department of Arizona!!

It is this chairman's privilege to introduce you to **Soldier's Best Friend**.

Soldier's Best Friend is an Arizona based program that provides United States military veterans living with combat-related Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) or Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) with Service or Therapeutic Companion Dogs, most of which are rescued from local shelters.

There is no cost to the veteran for the adoption and training. Most veterinary care is offered at reduced or no cost during the training period.

The goal for this year is for each area of the state, northern, southern, central Arizona, to raise enough money to sponsor one pairing of a veteran and dog. The cost for one pair is \$4,000.

Puppy-paw print jars have been distributed to each District to collect change from the units.

This chairman has issued a challenge to all Districts. The District that collects the most money in their jars, per capita, 30 days prior to Convention will receive a surprise from this chairman at Convention - lets here the clang, clang, of change (and paper)! The monies donated through Department from the Units will also count towards the District challenge.

Districts - When sending in your jar money, please use the following instructions to make sure you get appropriate credit. Send in a check to department, place the following in the memo line "President's Special Project Jar \$ District number."

This chairman will have a traveling donation collection for change collection, drop in change anytime you see it.

Every dollar donated to the new training center construction between now and September 15, 2016 will be matched up to \$250,000.
