Frequently Asked Questions

What cars are eligible to display?

All classic, vintage, exotic and street or race cars of interest are welcome.

Where is the car show held?

The car show is held at Raceway Woods on Route 31 in Carpentersville, Illinois.

Is there a charge to display my car?

Yes, there is a \$20.00 fee to display your car. (Advance registration \$15)
MiRPA Yearbook Included – Dash Plaques and Goodie Bags to the first 200 cars.

Where/how do I register?

Visit our website at www.mirpa.org, go to the Events page and print out the event registration form or register online.

What time may I enter?

You may begin entering for the car show after 9:00am.

What are the hours for the car show?

Car show hours are 10:00 am until 3:00 pm.

Where do I enter to display my car?

You will enter through the “Silo” entrance to Raceway Woods on Route 31. Follow the signs for **Display Car Entrance**

Where do I enter to display my car if I am arriving with a trailer?

We are able to accommodate your trailer.
Please advise us by calling (847) 421-2891 in advance of the event if you will be arriving with a trailer so we may direct you to the trailer entrance.

Where is the spectator parking?

There is a separate large spectator lot on Route 31 approx. a half mile south of the display car entrance (and north of Huntley Road – across from 141 N. Route 31, Carpentersville), which has easy access to the show field. Golf cart shuttles are available, or, you can walk via marked pathways. Please use this specified parking lot; the walk from other entrances is very long and neither lot is served by the shuttles.

What time is the show car judging?

Show car judging will close at 1 pm.

What time will award winners be announced?

Awards will be presented by 2:30 pm.

I want to park with my friends/club. How would I do that?

If you will be attending with friends or attending as a club, it is best if you all meet up at an outside location and then enter at one time. You will not be able to hold spaces.

I am selling my car. May I have a for sale sign visible?

In order to maintain the integrity of the event, "for sale" signs are not permitted on show cars.

Is there a charge for spectators?

Spectator enjoyment is free of charge.

(MIRPA is a recognized 501(c)(3) charity and will happily accept donations which allow this Meadowdale, Motorsports & Memories event continue into the future.)

How do spectators get from parking to the car show?

Spectators may enjoy a leisurely walk to the front straightaway of the racetrack. A golf cart shuttle will also be providing transportation between the **Spectator Parking Lot** and the car show continually throughout the day. *****PLEASE NOTE:** Transportation to the car show area is only available from the **Spectator Parking Lot!**

Due to Social Distancing protocols, a short wait may be required.

Will there be food and drinks available at the car show?

There will be pop and water available as well as a food stand.

Is there a rain date?

The Meadowdale, Motorsports & Memories Car Show is a rain or shine event.

Are Other Power Driven Mobility Devices (OPDMD) allowed at this event?

MIRPA has determined that due to the unique operational characteristics along with the rough and uneven terrain of this venue, and in the interest of the safety and security of all attendees and show cars, the use of other power driven mobility devices (OPDMD) by attendees will not be allowed.

This event is focused on the co-existence of high-volume pedestrian traffic, multiple forms of vehicular traffic and static display of high-value vehicles. Introducing the use by attendees of OPDMD into this mix would adversely affect MIRPA's commitment to the safety and security of all its attendees.
