## **Will your student fall victim to the effects of the**

Summer Slide is the term used to describe a student's learning loss over the summer. The average student **loses one to three months of learning over summer** according to National Center for Education Statistics.

Younger children are prone to the most learning loss because they're at a crucial stage in their development. "In general, kids learn a lot more in kindergarten, first grade, and second grade than kids in middle school or high school, because learning follows a curve where it's accelerated early in life and then plateaus," says James Kim, Ed.D., an assistant professor of education at Harvard University. "Things like decoding, letter knowledge, and word reading skills are very susceptible to decay without frequent practice, as are math facts like addition and subtraction." (Ashley Austrew, 6-5-2019)
