When Peter came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he was clearly in the wrong. (Galatians 2:11)






Galatians 2:11-21 Peter Reluctantly Serves the Gentiles

I explained in the open, to the voice speaking to me, that nothing unclean has entered me at any time.







 Truth is the validity of the collected fact.








3. Let Jesus <u>live</u> in you.
