Sunday Morning : Andrew Tseu, DDS presents “**The Hawaii Virtual Dental Home (Teledentistry) Pilot Project - Improving Oral Health Using Telehealth-Connected Dental Teams**” The Virtual Dental Home (VDH) is a community-based oral health delivery system in which people receive preventive services in community settings where they live or receive educational, social or general health services. It utilizes the latest technology to link practitioners in the community with dentists at remote office sites. Using the VDH system registered dental hygienists and dental assistants can keep people healthy in community settings by collecting diagnostic records, providing preventive procedures, education, and case management. Where more complex dental treatment is needed, the Virtual Dental Home connects patients with dentists in the area. This system promotes collaboration between dentists in dental offices and these community-based dental hygienists and dental assistants. Most importantly, it brings much-needed services to individuals who might otherwise receive no care.

Sunday Morning: Linda Austin presents “Eldercare: The Mouth to Body Connection for Healthier Living” Everyone ages.....As our elder clients leave our care how do we ensure that they will receive the same quality of care they need? Wendy Birtles, RDH, BS. Wendy Birtles RDH has been a practicing Dental Hygienist for over 30 yrs. For the past 18 yrs Wendy has been training clinicians around the world on ergonomic hand instrumentation and sharpening techniques. She is currently the Canadian Sales Manager for PDT Instruments.

Linda Austin, RDH, BS has a decades-long career that has evolved from her passion to educate and inspire people to improve their oral health. Linda developed her curiosity for research as an instructor at the University of Hawaii Dental Hygiene program. She also has over 30 years of experience working as a dental hygienist in the private sector, integrating evidence-based practice into her clinical work. Currently in the Department of Health, dental branch, Linda’s research focuses on oral health awareness and its implications for our kupuna and persons with disabilities. She works with community stakeholders in several projects, collaborating with University of the Pacific, public health nurses, care home operators, educators and students, DOH training units, UH College of Education, and senior centers. She hopes to stimulate oral-systemic awareness and inspire all health care providers to recognize the dental hygienist as a vital health team member in our community and institutions. Linda will present a topic that gets people’s attention which many dental hygienists have not faced.....yet.

Andrew Tseu, DDS is the Hawaii State Department of Health, Hospital & Community Dental Services Branch (“HCDSB”) Chief. The HCDSB provides comprehensive dental care services for the vulnerable and underserved populations in Hawaii that have limited access to dental treatment. The dental clinics serve as a community safety-net for the Medicaid aged, blind and disabled. Approximately one-third of the patients treated have an intellectual/development disability. The HCDSB operates five (5) dental clinics, and provides dental treatment in hospital settings. His experience also includes working in a private dental practice, working extensively with the Hawaii State Medicaid Dental Program, and practicing health care law. He is licensed to practice dentistry (D.D.S.) and law (J.D.).
