FREDERICK A. ZIMMER 1921 - 1995

Frederick A. Zimmer, 74, a native of Sebewaing, died Wednesday, Nov. 15, He and

his wife, Shirley, were residents of Rosemant, PA.

Mr. Zimmer was born in Sebewaing on September 1, 1921, the son of Edward and Clare (Auch) Zimmer. He was a grandson of Rev. J.J.F. Auch, the first missionary who came to the Sebewaing area to preach to the Chippewa Indians. Paster Auch was married to Anna Marie Erdman, and one of their children was a daughter, Clare, who was Mr. Zimmer's mother.

He attended immanuel Lutheran School, Sebeweing, and was a graduate of Sebeweing High, Class of 1939. He then attended Michigan State University, graduating in 1943. In World War II he served in the Philippines with the U.S. Army feld artillery, and was honorably discharged in 1946 as a first feutenent. He moved to Detroit where he began a five-decade cereer with Hastisians and Selis, one of the "Big Eight' international accounting firms. In 1949 he was married to Shirley Leeck. In 1963 the family moved to Philadelphia where in 1946 he became a partner in his firm.

He was a longitime member and worker for Grace Lutheran Church of Broomet, PA, serving as president, vice-president, secretary and elder, and of St. Paul's Lutheran

Church, Ardmore.

He is survived by his wife, Shirley J. Zimmer of Rosemont, one son, Fred Jr., 2 daughters, Cheryl and Michele, 5 grandchildren, 4 sisters and brothers-in-law, Doris and Bob Kerr of California, Bill and Marion Guillermety of South Carolina, Helan and Mal Rygh of Florida, and Margo and Joe Brodie of Michigan, and several nieces and nephews.
