Well done all that competed in this challenge. Great team event which saw the lead change hands many different times. Congratulations to The Horrible Hermits for their victory

Leg 1 – 3 miles

Gillian got '3 Ws and a P', using the teams joker card, off to a flying start. Cliff Cooper made full use of the age grading to bring 'Sting like a Bee' home in 2^{nd} , just ahead of Kev Sutcliffe and 'AIDe TriKe' (still trying to work out what that means) in 3^{rd} . Kev ran the fastest actual 3 mile time. Thanks to Richard Kerry for stepping in for the crocked Nigel Granville at short notice and getting 'The Fast and the Furious' off in 4^{th} .

Leg 2 - 4 miles

No jokers played on this leg, and with Ian Page running the fastest leg time coupled with the age grading, it meant that' 3 Ws and a P' extended their lead. The weather began to play a factor at this point of the race with a few people recording whinges and putting off their efforts, or getting their long legs out the way before the weather turned. (I won't mention names).

Leg 3 – 5 miles

Lots of change on this leg with the big guns beginning to show and a few more joker cards being played. Dean Smith celebrated starting his second half century with an excellent 5mile time which when coupled with the joker card, lifted the Trike boys from 2^{nd} to 1^{st} . 'The Fast and Furious' also played their joker, and Steve Roebuck made the most of it, lifting his team from 5^{th} to 2^{nd} . 
