1. Your Name and Child's name and grade if applicable.
2. Candidate Qualifications include:
 - a. At least 18 years or older
 - b. A Member of St. Peter's Parish or
 - c. A Parent of a child at MIQ
 - d. You are NOT an employee or the spouse of an employee of MIQ.
 - e. You do NOT have an immediate family member already on the Board as a voting member or Running for a Board seat. ("Immediate family" means father, mother, spouse, brother, sister, or child.)
3. Your reason for running for an MIQ board seat.

We will have a dinner to conclude the tournament at the MIQ Hall. The dinner will be from 6:30pm till 10:30 pm. and will include a DJ, Raffle Prizes, and a **Hosted Bar aka OPEN BAR**. The cost per person will be \$100.00 and will include the golf, golf cart, complimentary gift bag, 1 dinner ticket, and Hosted Bar. Each additional dinner ticket can be purchased for \$25.00.
