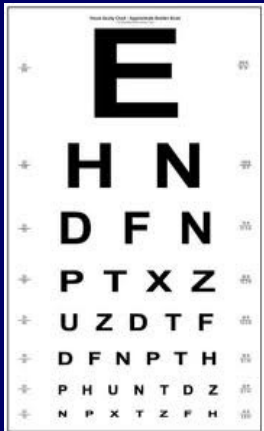

- Custom eyeglasses can help people who are Farsighted (Hyperopia) & Nearsighted (Myopia)



FLOW CHART

~APPLICATION PROCESS

Local Lions Club receives referral or application from patient, school nurse, etc.

~REVIEW PROCESS

Review and certification by local Lions Club to determine financial need. Local Lions Club faxes signed application to CURE Coordinator, who assigns application number. Referral to local Eye Care Provider (ECP) is made for an exam by Local Lions Club. If club does not have a existing relationship with an ECP they can download the Vision USA Application, complete it and fax it to NJ CURE for processing.

~EYE EXAM/FRAME SELECTION

Upon completion of exam by local Eye Care Provider (ECP), the client will choose from a selection of new frames donated by frame distributors to the pilot program.

~SELECTION OF LAB

The volunteer ECP completes the prescription and sends it to the finishing lab with frame for processing.

~FILL ORDER

Processed eyeglasses will be returned to the original Eye Care Provider for fitting and dispensing of eyeglasses.

GOALS

CONCEPT

- Clubs who choose to Opt-In to the NJ Pilot Program will save money for each patient, thus being able to serve more people using the same resources.

- NJLERC will pay for the entire cost of the eyeglasses if the patients qualify for the program. Local Lions Clubs will be asked to donate back a minimum amount to help sustain the program for the future.
