INSTRUCTIONS

In addition to the application, you will need to submit an original of the following attachments:

- 1. Full details of purpose and/or reason for improvement.
- 2. Site plan with scale drawings of exact dimensions of improvement showing location on property. Note distance from property lines. Show relationship of improvement to neighboring homes and/or open spaces.
- 3. Drawings and/or illustrations showing the design of proposed improvement—state architectural style of existing home.
- 4. Materials/Color:
 - a. List type of wood or other materials to be used.
 - b. Color: note whether color is the same as existing siding or trim on house or attach color chip for other color/stains.
- 5. Grading plan if changes in grad or other conditions adversely affecting drainage are anticipated (generally, approval will be denied if adjoining properties are adversely affected by changes in drainage).
- 6. Landscape plan if application is for landscaping or relevant to project.
- 7. Signed written agreement of affected lot owner if improvement falls on property line.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF APPLICANT

- 1. I understand that construction of certain major projects require that I obtain a City or County building permit. Approval of a project by the ACC does not affect or alter that requirement.
- 2. I understand that no construction activity shall take place prior to the approval of the ACC. If alterations are made prior to approval I may be required to return the property to its former conditions at my own expense if this application is not approved wholly or in part, and that I may be required to pay all legal expenses incurred if legal action becomes necessary.
- 3. I understand that members of the ACC are permitted to enter on my property to make reasonable inspection of proposed construction locations.
- 4. It is understood that I am aware of the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions and Architectural Controls with regard to the review process.
- 5. The alteration authority granted by this application will be revoked automatically if the alteration request has not commenced within three (3) months of the approval date.
- 6. I understand that any approval is contingent upon construction or alterations being completed in a workman-like manner as per plans submitted.
