Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer Jayne O'Brien noted the following. The General Fund began with a balance of \$965.85, there were no receipts, expenses were \$5.00, leaving a balance of \$960.85. The Athletic Hall of Fame began with a balance of \$5,148.17, there were no receipts and expenses were \$1500.00 (banquet deposit to Alpine Country Club), leaving a balance of \$3,648.17. There were no activity in the Grant Fund, leaving a balance of \$3,789.81. The Scholarship fund had a beginning balance of \$14,818.78, with deposits of \$100.00 and expenses of \$1,000 (Christina Torres, Class of 1974 Scholarship) leaving a balance of \$13,918.78, The total balance as of November 1, 2022 in the Washington Trust account was \$22,317.61.

Thanksgiving Report:

Monetary donations of \$1,045.00, gift cards \$180.00. Food Pantry \$65.00 for a total of \$1,290.00. 21 each \$50.00 gift cards were purchased from Price Rite (\$5.00 from General Fund) for a total of \$1,050.00.

Hall of Fame Committee Update:

Steve Bianchi reported they are working on letters, obtaining addresses and contact information for teams and for James Robinson.

Events Committee:

Paul Dolan reported the AHOF Induction Banquet will be held on Thursday, June 1st 2023 at the Alpine Country Club. The club seats 225 comfortably. The cost of the event will be \$90.00 per person with appetizers, entrée and dessert selected. Further details will be given at AHOF meeting.

Scholarship Report:

Paul Dolan reported that the Scholarship Committee consists of himself and Jayne O'Brien, asked for volunteers. Sharon Morris volunteered "Rob" who is an educator and recently joined the Alumni Association. Jayne suggested with over \$13,000 in funds and only three students out of five that had submitted the necessary paperwork this year that we forego the fundraising drive. Paul Dolan feels that continuity is key to success, he will compose a letter and contact Sal with a mid January target date for mailing.
