- 3. NO State Conservation materials are permitted in any arrangement. If you are not sure what this includes, contact Wayne Deal (864-764-5412, swdl9@aol.com), Endangered Species Chairman.
- 4. No artificial flowers or foliage is allowed. No painting or dyeing of fresh flowers is permitted.
- 5. Each garden club will be responsible for 4 designs.
- 6. Accessories may be used in all classes.
- 7. No cut or prepared food is allowed.
- 8. Some plant materials must be used in every exhibit.
- 9. Do not use plant shine on fresh flowers. Just wipe leaves with water and check for bug damage.

All arrangements will be staged against covered backboards (40" high x 30" wide). Arrangements should not extend above top or side of backboard. The flower show will be open to the public at 11:00 am Tuesday. NO ARRANGEMENTS MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE 4:00 PM ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 8.
