Need your machine cleaned? It might be time. We talked to Johnson's Sewing and they are willing to come up and do a service clinic.

Dates: July 11 – 13

Cost: If 20 people sign up, base cost is \$210/machine.

If more than 25 people sign up, \$165/machine.

Embroidery machines cost \$30 extra if the embroidery has to be tested. Long arm? If they can do it, the cost is \$195, including a house call.


