**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Work performed under this Contract includes the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, tools, incidentals, and supervision for:

Demolition, 18 Inch pipe installation, gate riser structure, inlet structure, outfall structure, automatic drainage gate, dewatering, sluice gate, subgrade preparation, ¾" aggregate base placement, compaction, dust control, SWPPP BMP's, and other work associated with the placement of aggregate base.

A meeting will be held for the purpose of reviewing and answering questions regarding this project. Attendance to this meeting is encouraged for any General Contractor submitting a bid and interested subcontractors. Attendance will be documented on a sign in sheet provided by the Agency. Any interested contractor or his/her agent may attend. Representatives of RD784 will be present for questions.

Award of this contract requires the bidder to have a valid California Contractor's License with the classifications identified above. Award of this contract also requires the bidder to demonstrate qualifications to perform the required work based upon having successfully installed storm drain pipelines and facilities having similar materials with the physical properties, lengths, and depths required for this project.

Each Bid must be submitted on the bid forms provided herein. Bids are required for the entirety of the work described herein. Each bid must also be accompanied by security in the form of a bid bond issued by a corporate surety, a certified check or cashier's check payable to RD784, or cash for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the aggregate sum of the bid.

The successful Bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and a Performance Bond, issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to RD784, each for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the original Total Contract Price.

RD784 encourages the submission of bids and sub-bids by minority-owned and woman-owned business enterprises.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

This is a construction project in accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code. This contract is subject to: (1) Federal Labor Standards Provisions as required by the Davis-Bacon Act and other applicable Federal requirements, (2) Equal Employment Opportunity requirements pursuant to Executive Order 11246, and (3) Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) development pursuant to Executive Order 12432.

All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. The higher of the two rates will be paid in accordance with the following acts and codes:

- (1) The Davis-Bacon Act, and
- (2) Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.
