- Dansville ArtWorks is seeking approximately 15 – 20 finished pieces for the UPCYCLED! online art auction using items donated to Dansville ArtWorks.
- Auction will be run online; photos and bios of artists will be posted with the item.
- The artist and Dansville ArtWorks will split the winning bid amount 50/50. Items not purchased at the auction become the property of Dansville ArtWorks for use in the gift shop or other fundraising purposes.
- Images of the donated items that will serve as the foundation for the upcycled auction item will be available for preview online and in person at ArtWorks starting June 13. Artists will be assigned a time slot during 7/25 – 7/27 to pick up the starter piece(s) of their choice based on the order the form is received at Dansville ArtWorks. Artist may use other materials to “flip” the piece; costs of materials and time should be factored into the item value.
- Attached please see a “Flip List” which artists can use to guide their design plan, and ArtWorks will use to promote the item.
- Finished pieces will be due to Dansville ArtWorks by 9/21.

Artist Agreement

I understand that I will be required to drop off items at designated times. After formally received by a Dansville ArtWorks representative, between the drop off and close of the auction, my work is insured against damage and theft for 50% of the value (value is auction item value minus 50% commission). Otherwise, I release Dansville ArtWorks, its Board of Directors, employees, volunteers, and the building landlords from any and all liability. Dansville ArtWorks is not responsible for items delivered early or dropped off without Dansville ArtWorks receipt. Items not sold in the auction will be considered a donation to Dansville ArtWorks. Sales of any submitted pieces paid to Dansville ArtWorks will be paid to the Artist within 15 business days of the close of the auction less 50% commission to Dansville ArtWorks unless noted in the inventory section. Furthermore, I agree to do my best to promote my participation in the Dansville ArtWorks auction to my networks which may include social media, websites, press releases, or groups in which I participate.

By signing below, I also agree to allow Dansville ArtWorks to use photos of my artwork for promotion of the auction and Dansville ArtWorks. I understand that I retain all rights to the images.
