#### From the President's Desk:

It's that time of year again, fall is approaching along with the various hunting seasons. Trap, rifle, pistol and archery range use will increase over the next couple of months. Please be mindful of the range rules. Safety first when going down range. Be sure EVERYONE on the range knows you are going down and be sure to turn on the lights and display

the orange signal flag. Wearing a bright orange or yellow shirt is a plus.

Members can have up to 3 guests on the ranges, and members MUST display their membership card. Be mindful of nonmembers using the ranges, this is the peak time of year for poaching on the ranges. If someone cannot produce a membership card, simply ask them to leave. If they refuse, you can call 911 to report a trespasser on a firing range, or simple back off, take note of their tag number and call me. Most of all, be nice. No one likes a range grouch.

Relatedly, range closures are noted on the online club calendar. ONLY dates that specifically say a range is closed, is it closed. The ranges are not closed for work days, setups or matches in the back, like the FunShoot.

Membership renewals will be in the mail to you soon. As I said last month, speedy return of those renewals saves a lot of headaches for all.

As always, feel free to each out to me for any reason. I especially want to hear any complaints.

#### **Head to Head Shoot-Off**

We will be doing head to head drag racing with guns. We will have a mirrored stage set up for two shooters to shoot at the same time. It's a lot of fun if you've never done it. You will be able to challenge other shooters to a head to head bout. A bout is the best 2 out of 3 runs. The cost will be \$10 per bout or \$5 per shooter per bout. On October 13 after the shoot off is finished (around 2:00) we will open the course up to call outs. If you are interested in calling out one of the guys in the top 16, Saturday will be the day to do it because some of them may not come back on Sunday. Just show up Saturday put the two shooters names on the signup sheet. It will be

done in the order of the sign up sheet. My suggestion is to show up early sign up and watch some of the shoot off.

If you want to signup Sunday the 14th we will start shooting at 9:00. To sign up for the shoot off email us at yorksignup@gmail.com with your name and the name of the person you are challenging. If you want to challenge but have not selected a challenger, just send in your name. Make sure the person you are challenging knows to be there. I will email you with the time of your shoot. If you have a time you prefer I will do my best to accommodate. I'm guessing around 15 mins a bout. Please show up at least 30 minutes early to your scheduled time. You should receive a confirmation within a day or two. We will run bouts until there are no more shooters or 3:00 If you don't want to sign up early and just show up Sunday that is fine but keep in mind we could pack up early if we don't have a big interest or it could be long wait times till your bout.
