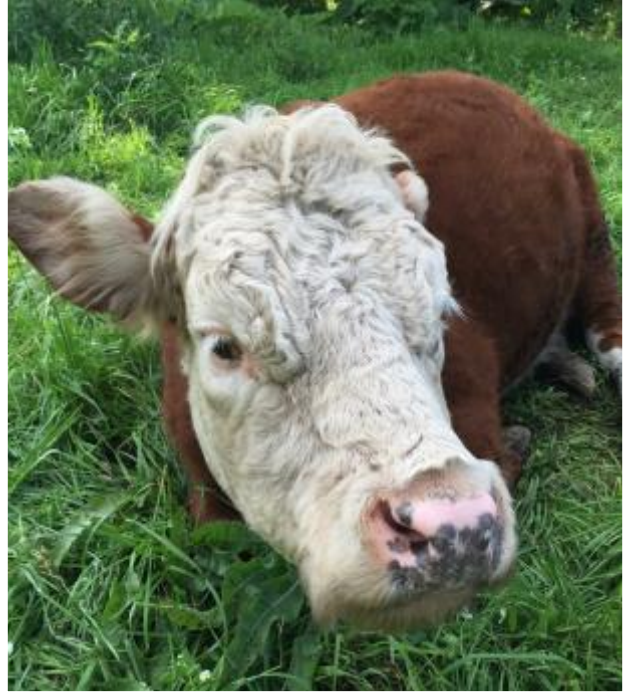

Elementary Clubhouse Programs & Enrichment

Students who join us will be offered monthly clubs to join and an opportunity to explore our property. Tutoring is also available for an additional fee and by appointment.

- **School Dismissal:** Aftercare Students will arrive via bus from school and have a snack.
- **4pm-5pm:** Clubs**/Recess/Homework. Depending on the number of children, students may choose from 1-2 clubs, recess/downtime, or finishing homework. Tutoring services are also available by appointment.
**Elementary Enrichment Club Only students will be signed up for specific clubs each day.
Drop-Off is at 4pm. Pick-Up is at 5pm.
- **5pm-6pm:** Homework and socialize with friends. Weather permitting, we will encourage all students to get some fresh air and explore outside.
- **6pm:** All programs are done for the day and students go home.

Sample Club Descriptions

Leadership, Team Work, Fun, Adventure

Art Club: Students will be introduced to a variety of arts and crafts projects from home made piñatas to canvas art to drawing cartoons and more. Students will have the opportunity to paint, sketch, and make all types of messy creations leaving the mess at school instead of bringing it home.

Book Club: Students will pick from a list of books each month. Imaginative and interactive activities will enhance comprehension and help encourage even our hesitant readers to keep up with the group. At the end of the month, there will be a Battle of the Books contest with prizes for all.

Leadership Adventure Club: This session is perfect to help develop our young leaders with team building skills through animal encounters, outdoor adventures, age-appropriate construction projects like building a tree house or animal enclosures. During each session, the group will choose from a list of service projects to be completed on the property. This experience will be valuable to help develop team building skills for our future leaders. This will be for students in 3rd-5th grade.

Polish Club: Bi-lingual Polish and English speaking students will have the opportunity to learn to read and write in Polish. This class will focus on giving students a solid foundation of the Polish language. This class will be taught by Ms. Sylwia who was a chemistry teacher in Poland. She will add some excitement and new science vocabulary to the class with science experiments throughout the hour.
