He has been a Reader, Table Leader and Question Leader for the AP English Language and Composition exam since 1995, and from 2005 – 2009 he served on the Test Development Committee for AP English Language and Composition. He is co-author of Teaching Non-Fiction in AP English (2011, 2005), The Language of Composition: Reading, Writing, Rhetoric (2012, 2008), Literature and Composition: Reading, Writing, thinking (2017, 2010), and Conversations in American Literature: Language, Rhetoric, Culture (2015), all published by Bedford/ St. Martin's.
