Scholarship applicants,

Carmel United Soccer Club sponsors the Christopher Tompkins Memorial Tournament, as well as other fund raising events, to establish a scholarship fund for graduating seniors involved in the Club. This year we are able to offer scholarships to the graduating class of 2017. As a graduating senior involved with the Club, you may be eligible to receive a scholarship. The selection committee is now accepting written applications for consideration. The amount of the scholarship has ranged between \$200 and \$250 in the past depending on the number of qualified applicants.

The criteria for consideration are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be an active 2016-2017 member of the Carmel United Soccer Club as a player, coach, or referee. If there is not a viable team for the applicant to play on for the 2016-2017 season, the applicant must have at one time played within the club. Proof of this must be in indicated your essay.
- 2. Applicant must live in the Carmel Central School District.
- 3. Applicant must have a B average or better for his/her senior year and must provide a copy of a current report card with grade point average and rank in class signed by your guidance counselor.
- 4. Applicant must graduate by June 2017 and plan to attend a school of higher education.
- 5. Applicant must submit a 250 word essay on his/her goals for the future and include how the club and the sport of soccer has affected their lives.
- 6. Applicant must be available for a personal interview at the discretion of the committee.
