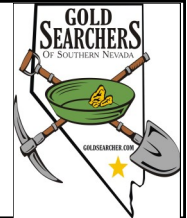
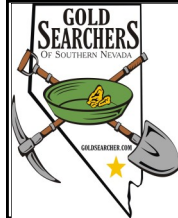

Minutes Sept 2, 2015

The GSSN met on Sept 2, 2015 at the American Legion all in Henderson Nevada. President John Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm and led in the pledging allegiance to the flag. Officers present included Vice President Mike Ameling, Secretary Delores Gee, and Membership Chairman Steve Christensen. Treasurer Mark Hedges was out of town. All were welcomed (69 signed in with 6 guests). John Asked for a motion to approve the August 2015 minutes as published in the Highgrader. Morris Seguin made such a motion which was seconded by Mert Black. All voted in favor and the motion was approved. In the absence of the treasurer John gave the treasurers report. Jake Jakl made a motion to approve the report which was seconded by Jim Scrogus. Unanimous approval, motion carried. Members report showed 7 new members with 12 renewals, with a total membership of 394 active members. All were invited to George N's breakfast meeting at the jokers wild on Sept 8 at 9:00 am on Bolder Hwy. George N made an announcement regarding the new t-shirts, hats, and jackets with the club logo on the front. Steve from desert outfitters and Jake from Jakes Mining Co. each gave a 1 minute presentation on each of their own business in the Las Vegas Valley. Small miners exemptions (SME) and affidavits were filed on all of the clubs current claims securing them for another season. POA forms and quit claim forms were sent to current claimants for GSSN for renewal with BLM. Affidavits for Organizational tax exemption on the 40 acre property was filed on August 24, 2015. We are waiting for a ruling from Mohave County.

With the elections upcoming in November the election committee was selected from volunteers and include Morris Seguin (Chairman), Ron Balsamo, Mert Black, and Rick Young. Thanks to these volunteers. Xmas dinner was also discussed. It was decided to cater three main courses (turkey, ham chicken or roast beef). The decision will be made in the future. Kathy volunteered to head up the dinner committee. Again, thanks goes to the volunteers.

VP Mike discussed the by-law revision. The entire by-law revision will be posted on the website and will be voted on at the October meeting.

The next outing will be at the Lost Change claim (old 28) on September 19-20. If you plan on attending please RSVP the club website before September 15 so we can get an accurate count on the number of attendees so we can plan on enough food. The newly acquired 40 acre property will be staked and posted for easy identification. The president and a couple of volunteers will be headed out there on Tuesday to placer the corner markers.
