The GSSN met on Sept 2, 2015 at the American Legion all in Henderson Nevada. President John Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm and led in the pledging allegiance to the flag. Officers present included Vive President Mike Ameling, Secretary Delores Gee, and Membership Chairman Steve Christensen. Treasurer Mark Hedges was out of town. All were welcomed (69 signed in with 6 guests). John Asked for a motion to approve the August 2015 minutes as published in the Highgrader. Morris Seguin made such a motion which was seconded by Mert Black. All voted in favor and the motion was approved. In the absence of the treasurer John gave the treasurers report. Jake Jakl made a motion to approve the report which was seconded by Jim Scrogus. Unanimous approval, motion carried. Members report showed 7 new members with 12 renewals, with a total membership of 394 active members.
