

Nestled among the hills of western Morris County, Schooley's Mountain Park offers visitors 797 acres of active and passive recreation facilities. The active recreational facilities of the park include a ballfield, fishing, and a play area near the lake picnic grove. A 470 foot floating bridge, is one of the most unique aspects of the park system, which provides access to the lake from the newly renovated Lodge. The natural amphitheater is the site of concerts during the Summerfest, and the group shelter is filled to capacity with weekend picnickers from May through September.

## Turn LEFT onto Noughright Rd. go 3.3 miles

## Turn RIGHT onto Eost Springtown Rd. go . 4 mile

Turn LEFT into Pork stroight to the end of the rood
(Hondicap: ofter entering park turn right ot sign "Fomily Picnic Site/Boot House" etc. Go to end,"Uuthorized Vehicles Only "sign, turn left go up hill to Hondicap parking, next to restrooms and to the right of the Povilion.)
